# Approval of Minutes

- A. President Lally welcomed NYSPHSAA Assistant Director Joe Altieri to the meeting.
- B. President Lally congratulated the Section XI Scholar/Athlete Team Award winners from the fall 2007-08 sports season.

#### **II. REPORTS**

# A. EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Board met on Wednesday, January 2, 2008, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President L. Lally, R. Goldin, C. Delargy, W. Shierant, M.A. Jules, N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson, A. Van Cott, L. Schwartz, P. Ferenz, K. Seaman, L. Light, D. Lunetta (Items 1-5), and E. Cinelli. (Absent: J. Finello).

- 1. <u>President</u> Lisa Lally called the meeting to order at 4:06 pm. Ms. Lally congratulated Paula Nickerson for being chosen "Athletic Director of the Year" by the Suffolk County Athletic Directors.
- 2. NYSPHSAA Paula Nickerson, Nick DeCillis and Ed Cinelli provided information regarding the October 29, 2007 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee Meeting. Paula Nickerson announced that Section XI overwhelmingly approved the 2007 Referendum regarding the classification of "Charter" school members. She also informed the Executive Board that the NYSPHSAA is seeking applications for the NYSPHSAA Assistant Director vacancy created by Lloyd Mott's retirement.
- 3. 2006-07 Audit The 2006-07 Audit and Management Letter were reviewed by Deirdre Lunetta from the accounting firm of Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP. Discussion took place regarding the Designated and Undesignated Net Assets. Ms. Lunetta recommends that the Section consider providing a systematic approach to distributing a portion of the net assets to the member schools.

In a motion made by Paula Nickerson and seconded by Charlie Delargy, the Executive Board "rescinded" the March 14, 2006 and January 10, 2007 Executive Board action that designated \$500,000 and \$100,000 respectively for future capital needs.

4. <u>Finance Committee</u> - Section XI Finance Committee Chairman, Alan Van Cott, reviewed the December 6, 2007 Finance Committee meeting report as well as the proposed 2008-09 budget. The Finance Committee approved the 2008-09 budget which contains no increase in Dues and Service Charges, and the appropriation of \$126,308 to the budget from the Fund Balance.

#### 5. Management Letter

- A. The Executive Director provided the Board with a response to the September 26, 2007 Management Letter.
- B. In a motion made by Pete Ferenz and seconded by Nick DeCillis, the Executive Board approved "Corporate Accounting Solutions, Inc." (CAS), to provide a review of Section XI's books and records and to provide assistance with adjustments that may be necessary to provide Section XI with accurate financial reports. CAS will provide Section XI with assistance during 2007-08 for the June 30, 2008 fiscal year-end close at a rate not to exceed \$5,000.
- 6. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> Treasurer Larry Light provided an overview of the Section XI Profit and Loss Budget vs. Actual, July 1, 2007 through December 27, 2007. It was noted that "Sport Expenses" were extremely high due to the cost of the Fall 2007 NYSPHSAA Championship costs. Section XI sent thirteen teams to NYSPHSAA Championships in boys' soccer, girls' soccer, field hockey and girls' volleyball.

# 7. Counsel – Kevin Seaman

- A. Mr. Seaman provided the Board with information regarding a "FOIL request." Executive Director Ed Cinelli will send the requested information.
- B. Mr. Seaman reviewed an appeal lodged by the Elwood Public Schools relative to the disqualification of a wrestler for the 2007-08 season.
- C. Mr. Seaman provided an opinion regarding the limitation of photographers at Section sporting events. Section XI will continue to provide field access to newspaper and media personnel. However, the Section will not provide field access to photographers who are "selling" photos and videotapes of Section XI championship events.
- D. Mr. Seaman provided an opinion regarding the use of metal bats in baseball.
- E. Mr. Seaman reviewed a court case that involved a high school cheerleader's personal injury claim. The New York State Supreme Court concluded that the school district did not fail to provide safeguards against the risk of falling off a mat during practice.
- 8. <u>Officials Negotiations</u> Nick DeCillis informed the Board on the progress of negotiations with the Suffolk County Officials Association. The next negotiations session will take place on Monday, January 7, 2008, at 4 pm, at the Section XI office.

# 9. President Lisa Lally

- A. Ms. Lally provided the Executive Board with the Internal Claims Auditor's report for November, 2007.
- B. Ms. Lally informed the Executive Board that she met with the Executive Director to review his 2006-07 evaluation. Lisa thanked the Board for their cooperation in providing comments in the evaluation.
- 10. <u>NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame Nominations</u> The Executive Director informed the Board that nominations have been received by the NYSPHSAA for Jack Foley, Boomer Esiason and Sal Ciampi.
- 11. <u>Section XI Quarterly Expenses: Meals and Refreshments</u> The Executive Director provided the Executive Board with the meals and refreshments expenses for the period October 1, 2007 through January 1, 2008.
- 12. <u>Lease Extension</u> The Executive Director provided the Executive Board with a draft of a Lease Extension and Amendment Agreement with Damianos Realty Group LLC. The Board requested further clarification regarding this amendment. The Executive Director will provide a lease for the Board to consider at the February 28, 2008 Executive Board meeting.
- 13. Check Signing Procedure The Executive Board approved the following procedure regarding the electronic signing of checks: "The Executive Director is authorized to establish a system of signing checks in Section XI. The system must require the physical presence of two individuals authorized by the Executive Board to electronically sign checks. No one person is approved to sign a check. Two backup designees will be approved should the authorized individuals be unavailable. Additionally, all payments must be approved by the Executive Director prior to the processing of a check. Furthermore, all procedures as established in the financial policies regarding the claims auditor must be adhered to."
- 14. <u>Past President Recognition</u> The Executive Board approved expenditure for the recognition of the President of the Section XI Executive Board.

- 15. <u>Part-Time Employee</u> The Executive Board approved the hiring of a Section XI part-time employee for the 2007-08 school year not to exceed \$5,000. The funds to compensate this employee will be allocated from the Fund Balance.
- 16. <u>Admissions Incident</u> The Executive Director provided a report to the Executive Board regarding an admissions incident that took place at William Floyd High School on November 10, 2007. The Executive Director will continue to monitor the procedures involving admission to Section XI championship events.
- 17. Cheerleading A discussion took place regarding the concern for cheerleading that was raised by Section XI athletic directors at a recent meeting. The Executive Board supports the current status of cheerleading in Section XI: "Section XI recognizes cheerleading as a support activity for interscholastic athletics (and that is not to be classified as a sport). As such qualifications of advisors need be neither more nor less than those currently in existence and will remain the prerogative of each school district. A mandatory clinic for cheerleading advisors will be scheduled each September."
- 18. <u>Wrestling Infectious Diseases Workshop</u> The Executive Director provided the Board with information regarding the Section XI Wrestling Infectious Diseases Workshop that was conducted on Wednesday, October 17, 2007. The workshop was attended by approximately 200 athletic directors and wrestling coaches from our member schools. The guest speakers, Bruce J. Anderson from Minnesota and Anthony Donatelli from Bayport, provided a great deal of information to assist coaches and athletic directors in the prevention, identification and treatment of infectious skin diseases in wrestling and other sports.
- 19. <u>Staff Heath Insurance</u> The Executive Director provided the Board with information regarding the application process for family health insurance that involved a Section XI employee and NYSPHSAA Treasurer Kathy Higle. Ed Cinelli will send correspondence to Kathy Higle, informing her again that Section XI will not be responsible for the application for family health coverage and billing.
- 20. Newsday High School Sports Blog The Executive Director provided the Board with information regarding Newsday's decision to cancel the high school sports blog due to the many inappropriate and negative comments that it fostered. Georgia McCarthy, Lisa Lally, Tim Mullins, Jeremy Thode and Ed Cinelli met with Hank Winnicki, Newsday Sports Editor. Mr. Winnicki informed them that the Newsday high school blog and talkback will require registration for use and will contain a filtering system. Section XI was very pleased with his response to these concerns. He asked to be notified of any problems or concerns that Section XI may have with the Newsday website. - 21. <u>Notice of Subsequent Arrest</u> The Executive Director provided the latest information regarding subsequent arrest of officials.
- 22. <u>Goals and Objectives</u> The Executive Director provided his 2007-08 Goals and Objectives Mid-Year Report.
- 23. <u>Travel Policies</u> The Executive Director provided information regarding the following policy with respect to student-athletes' travel to state championships: "To be eligible to compete, all athletes must use the transportation provided by Section XI."

  Recently, a school district questioned why this was required as there was a conflict that a student-athlete had with a NYSSMA presentation.

- 24. <u>NYSPHSAA Budget and Finance Committee</u> The Executive Director provided the minutes of the NYSPHSAA Budget and Finance Committee meeting that was held on October 29, 2007.
- 25. <u>Friend and Neighbor</u> Notification was sent to the Stella Maris Regional School in November 2007 from the NYSPHSAA, informing the school that their Friend and Neighbor status expires in January 2008. At this time, we have not received a request to renew this status.
- 26. <u>Future State Championships Sites</u> The Executive Director provided the Board with the most current listing of future NYSPHSAA championship dates and sites.
- B. <u>NYSPHSAA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE</u> N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson At its October 29, 2007 meeting, the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:
  - 1. <u>Structure and Policy Review Committee</u> Approved the Structure and Policy Review Committee's recommendations be taken back to the Sections for review and discussion. At the February Executive Committee the recommendations will be voted on.
  - 2. <u>Non-Public Schools</u> Approved to extend the experiment for the classification of non-public schools for one year.

# 3. Wrestling

- Approved changing the 275-pound weight class to 285 pounds in Wrestling.
- Approved in Section XI an experiment that would require a doctor's stamped signature along with the doctor's signature, address and phone number on the Wrestling Skin Disease form.
- Approved an increase in the number of working officials at the Wrestling State Tournament by two based on the increase in the number of wrestlers due to the at-large bids.
- 4. <u>Boys' Basketball</u> Approved in Boys' Basketball to permit each Section the opportunity to experiment with two 16-minute halves rather than four 8-minute quarters for the 2008-09 season in tournament and non-league games only.
- 5. New Members Approved as New Members: Kipp Tech Valley Charter School (2); International Charter School of Schenectady (2); Immaculate Conception (4); Elizabeth A. Clune Montessori School (4); Tapestry Charter School (6); and Oracle Charter School (6).

# 6. Handbook Committee

- Approved to support the Handbook Committee's work of the concept of establishing fines and other penalties when rules and regulations of the Association are violated.
- Approved the Handbook Committee's recommendation for a referendum vote to permit the classification of Charter Schools using the same process as non-public schools.
- 7. <u>Mileage</u> Approved establishing the IRS mileage rate in January of the year the budget is made to be the mileage reimbursement rate for the following fiscal year.

8. Softball - Approved the appointment of Jim Miller as Modified Softball Coordinator.

#### 9. Modified Program

- Approved an editorial change for multi-school contests under the Modified General Eligibility Rule #10: "The statement 'For multi-school contests, refer to General Eligibility Rule #10' should also be included in the Game Rules and Conditions for cross-country. (Reference: NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg. 104, add as Game Rule #3), swimming, (pg. 115, add as Game Rule #6) and track and field (pg. 117, add as Game Rule #10)."
- Approved an editorial change for clarification of double headers in Modified Softball and Baseball. "A team may play two games in one day twice during a season, either a double header against a single opponent, or two successive games against two different opponents. Double header restrictions must be followed."
- Approved an editorial change under the Modified Wrestling Game Rule #9, "Modified Wrestling Game Rule #9 (Reference: NYSPHSAA Handbook, page 118) should be deleted. The re-written multi-school contest rule makes it a moot point. It will be replaced with: 'For multi-school contests, refer to General Eligibility Rule #10'."
- 10. <u>Baseball Umpires</u> Approved a request by the New York State Baseball Umpires to wear a light blue or red shirt in addition to the approved navy shirt at high school baseball games.

# C. NYSPHSAA - Assistant Director Joe Altieri

Mr. Altieri provided information from a draft of the NYSPHSAA January Office Report. The report will be distributed to all athletic administrators later this month. Highlights from the report follow:

- 1. Applications are being sought for the Assistant Director position currently held by Lloyd Mott.
- 2. State Sports Committee meetings were reviewed in Boys' Soccer, Girls' Soccer, Wrestling and Baseball.
- 3. There is an effort to coordinate the rules and regulations in both Boys' and Girls' Soccer, including overtime periods and tie breaking procedures.
- 4. Wrestling is considering a regional competition.
- 5. Baseball is considering a two-day format for the state championships.
