II. REPORTS**A. EXECUTIVE BOARD**

The Section XI Executive Board met on Monday, May 12, 2008, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President L. Lally, R. Goldin, W. Shierant, M.A. Jules, N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson, A. Van Cott, P. Ferenz, K. Seaman, L. Light, J. Sexton and E. Cinelli. (Absent: C. Delargy, J. Finello, L. Schwartz)

1. President - President Lisa Lally called the meeting to order at 4:04 pm.
2. Claims Auditor Reports – Lisa Lally reviewed the March and April 2008 Claims Auditor Reports. Executive Director Ed Cinelli provided information regarding the issues that the Internal Auditor indicated on these reports concerning documentation.
3. Appointment – The Board approved the appointment of Matteo DeVincenzo, Athletic Director from Comsewogue, as the Section XI representative to the NYSPHSAA “Life of an Athlete” program.
4. NYSPHSAA Reports – Paula Nickerson/Nick DeCillis
 - A. Ms. Nickerson reported on the May 2, 2008 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting. She highlighted state action items that were approved at the meeting as well as the April 2008 Office Report.
 - B. Ms. Nickerson announced that Section XI will have three inductees into the NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame this summer: Jack Foley, Boomer Esiason, and Sal Ciampi.
 - C. The 2008-09 championship dates and sites were reviewed, as well as the NYSPHSAA Budget and Finance Committee Meeting report of March 15, 2008.
 - D. Executive Director Ed Cinelli informed the Executive Board that the state has eliminated the championship entry fees for 2008-09. Section XI will not be billed \$3,200 for this item.
 - E. Executive Director Ed Cinelli provided information to the Executive Board regarding the possibility of state championships in boys’ volleyball in the fall of 2009.
5. Treasurer’s Report – Larry Light
 - A. Mr. Light reviewed with the Executive Board the Profit and Loss vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2007, through May 9, 2008.
 - B. Mr. Light highlighted that sport expenses for the Section during this school year were extremely high due to the success of Section XI teams qualifying for state championships.
 - C. Mr. Light reviewed the process by which the new Section XI accounting firm, Corporate Accounting Solutions, will be closing the Section XI books at the end of the fiscal year.
6. Staff Health Insurance – The Executive Board approved Section XI staff health insurance for Donna Madison through Blue Cross/Blue Shield, represented by United Benefit Consulting, Inc., as broker, beginning June 1, 2008 for a period of one year. Section XI will end its health insurance relationship with the New York State Public High School Athletic Association effective June 1, 2008.
7. Officials’ Negotiations – Nick DeCillis reviewed the proposed Officials’ Contract with the Executive Board. He announced that the officials’ associations have approved this contract. Athletic Council action is required for final approval.

8. Counsel – Kevin Seaman

- A. Mr. Seaman reviewed with the Executive Board the correspondence from Carla Varriale regarding *Dowd vs. County of Suffolk*, an incident that occurred at Suffolk County Community College on November 11, 2006.
- B. Mr. Seaman reviewed correspondence to Bay Shore Athletic Director Claude Kasman regarding an incident that occurred on February 26, 2008, at Stony Brook University.
- C. Mr. Seaman reviewed correspondence Section XI received regarding the suspension of Northport athletes as a result of their actions on April 1, 2008.
- D. Mr. Seaman reviewed correspondence from Patchogue-Medford Athletic Director Tom Combs regarding the suspension of a JV boys' lacrosse player as a result of his actions at an April 1, 2008 contest.
- E. Mr. Seaman reviewed a letter from Executive Director Ed Cinelli to a boys' lacrosse official regarding his actions at an April 23, 2008 contest at West Islip High School.
- F. Mr. Seaman reviewed correspondence with NYSPHSAA Executive Director Nina Van Erk regarding family health coverage applied for by a Section XI employee.

9. Nominating Committee – The Nominating Committee recommends the following slate for 2007-08:

A referendum ballot will be sent to all member schools.

- 10. Section XI Quarterly Expenses: Meals and Refreshments – The Executive Director provided the Executive Board with the meals and refreshments expenses for the period February 28, 2008 through May 10, 2008.
- 11. Executive Director Goals and Objectives – The Executive Director presented a final report on his goals and objectives for the 2007-08 school year. He also provided a draft of his goals and objectives for 2008-09.
- 12. Section XI Tentative 2008-09 Calendar – The Executive Director provided a copy of the Section XI tentative calendar for 2008-09.
- 13. Section XI Website Advertising – The Executive Board approved a fee of \$150 per month to be charged to advertisers on the Section XI website during the 2008-09 school year.
- 14. Oaktree Systems – The Executive Board approved a contract with Oaktree Systems, Inc., for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010.
- 15. Sportsmanship Committee – The Executive Director discussed with the Executive Board details of the Sportsmanship Workshop that will be conducted on September 24, 2008.

He also informed the Board of a revision to the sportsmanship rating using the term "spectator" and a rating system of 1-5 to be provided on all Section XI rating cards.

16. NYSPPHSAA Financial Concerns – The Executive Director provided correspondence from Section II Executive Director Doug Kenyon to NYSPPHSAA Executive Director Nina Van Erk regarding increased state expenditures that are impacting the Sections.
 17. Gate Receipts – The Executive Director provided a six-year graph of the gate receipts for championship contests in boys' and girls' basketball, wrestling and football.
 18. Fact Finder – A report was reviewed with the Executive Board regarding an incident concerning the East Islip Varsity Softball team on April 26, 2008.
 19. Seeding Committee – The Executive Director provided a memo from Seeding Committee Chairman, Mike Tully, regarding the Committee's results for the winter 2008 season. Mr. Tully continues to provide outstanding leadership to this Committee, providing a synopsis at the end of each season.
- B. NYSPPHSAA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE – N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson
At its May 2, 2008 meeting, the NYSPPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:
1. Track & Field – Approved for a two-year experiment beginning in the 2009 season to adjust the qualifying standards in Division I and II. The divisions would have separate At-Large entries setting the qualifying standards higher in Division I and lower in Division II. The standards would be determined by the average of the 6th place finisher in each Division from the last three years.
 2. Wrestling - Approved for a wrestler to compete twice in a regular dual meet under specific situations pertaining to forfeits and exhibition matches.
 3. Boys Soccer – Approved the following:
Regular season overtime procedure will be two 10-minute sudden victory periods. In regular season tournaments when teams need to advance, there will be two 10-minute sudden victory periods; and if still tied, penalty kicks will be used to determine advancement. In Sectional and State Tournament games, overtimes will consist of two 15-minute sudden victory periods; and if still tied, penalty kicks. However, in the state final championship game, Co-Champions will be declared at the end of the two 15-minute periods with no penalty kicks.
 4. Girls Soccer – Approved the following:
Regular season overtime procedure will be two 10-minute periods (played fully). If still tied, the game will end in a tie. In regular season tournaments when teams need to advance, there will be two 10-minute periods (played fully); and if still tied, penalty kicks will be used to determine advancement. In Sectional and State Tournament games, overtimes will consist of two 10-minute periods (played fully) followed by two 5 minute sudden victory periods. If still tied, penalty kicks will be used to determine the winner. However, in the state final championship game, Co-Champions will be declared at the end of the two 5-minute periods with no penalty kicks.
 5. Student Athlete Advisory Committee - Approved of Murphee Hayes as the coordinator of the Student Athlete Advisory Committee.

6. Sport Coordinator Appointments - Approved Kathy Ferrari (girls bowling), Wayne Inman (boys bowling), Jim Amen (boys lacrosse assistant), Jamie Harter (girls golf assistant).
7. 2008-09 Championship Sites and Dates - Approved for Girls Swimming @Erie County Community College, Boys Swimming & Diving @Nassau Aquatic Center, Boys and Girls Bowling @Gates Bowl and Softball at Waterloo High School. Girls Volleyball will November 15- 16, 2008.
8. Girls Volleyball – Approved to begin the Championship Finals on Sunday at 10:00 AM.
9. Championship Entry Fees - Approved the elimination of Championship Entry Fees in 2008-09 for all NYSPHSAA individual state tournaments. This reflects a revenue loss of \$50,900.
10. Boys Lacrosse - Approved a variation of cut off numbers. Class A: 1100 & up; Class B: 650–1099; and Class C: 649 & below.
11. Girls and Boys Swimming - Approved as a one-year trial the use of the 30th place preliminary time at the NYSPHSAA Championship meet to develop the qualifying time for individual events and the 15th place preliminary time for relay events.
12. Classification Committee - Approved the establishment of a statewide Classification Committee to review the classification of non public schools.
13. Extended Playing Time – Approved the Section VIII Modified extended playing time program.
14. Outside Agencies – Approved the form to be used for Outside Agencies.
15. Championship Advisory Committee – Approved the Association staff to hold joint sport committee meetings in sports that have both boys’ and girls’ teams in order to address equity issues and report back to the CAC with recommendations/reports by October 2008.
16. Appeals – Approved the establishment of a \$200 filing fee for all appeals.

ACTION ITEM FOR AUGUST MEETING

1. Modified Committee - Requesting a two (2) contest increase in the maximum number of contests permitted in the following sports: badminton, baseball, basketball, bowling, field hockey, golf, gymnastics, ice hockey, lacrosse, skiing, soccer, softball, tennis, track and volleyball. The committee also recommends permitting wrestling to be allowed 14 points.

C. NYSPHSAA EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR – Nina Van Erk

Ms. Van Erk reviewed the May, 2008, NYSPHSAA May Office Report with the Athletic Council. She also highlighted the following:

1. Fencing – Ms. Van Erk reviewed a conference call that took place with Sections I, VIII and XI participating, with respect to issues regarding the coordination of fencing rules among the Sections. A NYSPHSAA fencing booklet will be produced for use in

the future.

2. Hall of Fame – Ms. Van Erk announced the 2008 NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame inductees, indicating that three of them are from Section XI.
3. Non-Public Schools – Ms. Van Erk presented information regarding the classification of non-public schools and stated that a committee was formed to discuss this issue.
4. Equity in Participation – The state will be working to align sports in which both boys and girls participate, with a goal to follow common rules and regulations.
5. Eligibility and Sportsmanship Workshop – Ms. Van Erk announced that on September 24, 2008, Section XI will hold a mandated Eligibility and Sportsmanship Workshop.
6. Adapted Athletics – Ms. Van Erk announced the state has developed a task force to study and make recommendations regarding a competitive adapted athletic program.

D. COUNSEL – Kevin Seaman

1. Mr. Seaman reviewed misconducts by student-athletes and an official during contests this spring.
2. Mr. Seaman reviewed Commissioner's Decision No. 15,497 regarding selection classification and Decision No. 15,575 regarding extension of eligibility. He highlighted that there are three phases to the selection classification process that all school districts must follow. V. NEW BUSINESS

1. Sportsmanship Ratings – Scott Reh from Conference III raised the issue of Sportsmanship ratings as they apply to spectators. Their concern is that Section XI uses ratings for athletes, coaches and spectators at all contests to determine which schools win sportsmanship awards. Conference III feels that spectators should not be included in the cumulative rating of sportsmanship as they do not reflect the sportsmanship of coaches and student-athletes. Rather, those spectator ratings should be separate from coaches and athletes. After discussion, the Athletic Council approved a motion by Scott Reh and seconded by Georgia McCarthy for this item to be discussed at a Sportsmanship Committee meeting prior to the start of the fall 2008 season.
2. Recognition – Lisa Lally thanked Wayne Shierant and Alan Van Cott for their years of service to Section XI. Wayne served on the Executive Board over the past eight years, including two years as President. Alan was congratulated on his retirement and thanked for his service as Section XI's NYSPHSAA Superintendent Representative to the Central Committee and as Chairman of Section XI's Finance Committee.
3. Presentation – Ross Goldin presented Lisa Lally with an award to thank her for serving as Section XI President from 2006-2008.
