II. NYSPHSAA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

- A. Wrestling – “Shall the 96 lb and 285 lb weight classes be mandatory for all high school competitions – Duals and Tournaments – beginning with the 2010-11 season.”
- B. Field Hockey – “Shall there be a waiver of the solid white/dark shirts for the 2010 Fall season (only if needed).”
- C. Baseball – “Shall, by mutual agreement of the Section’s Executive Directors, Section Coordinators and Athletic Directors, schools have the option of playing Monday scheduled regional games on Sunday.” Rationale: This would allow for better facilities, potential for bigger crowds, and less time out of school.
- D. Girls’ Lacrosse – “Shall, in games when 100% playing time is required (all Sectional, Regional and State Semi-Finals and Finals), the game be resumed from the point of interruption on the next available date. Teams that have possession at the point of interruption will retain possession in a draw alignment with the opposing center 4 meters away. If there is no team possession, it will be a draw.”
- E. Girls’ and Boys’ Tennis – “Shall, in Sectional competition, Sections have the option to increase the number of matches to four in one day using modified scoring. The rest periods would be 30 minutes for the quarter final and below, 45 minutes for the semi-finals, and 60 minutes for the finals.” (The committees would like to take this proposal to the Safety Committee. The Boys Committee would like to have approval for the regular season as well.)

III. SECTION ACTION ITEMS

- A. **Tournament** – The Tournament Committee met on Thursday, February 4, 2010, at 10:00 am, at the Holbrook Country Club. In attendance: Acting Chair T. Combs; Conference I: J. Mankowich; Conference II: J. Pennacchio, T. Horan; Conference III: J. Vasile-Cozzo, J. Tasman; Conference IV: D. Phillips, R. Mayo. Also in attendance: E. Cinelli. (Absent: W. Shierant, J. Sparacio, J. Valente)

Information Only:

Section XI Boys’ Volleyball Chair, John Mankowich, presented two Boys’ Volleyball tournament proposals to the Committee. The Committee recommended that the Placement Committee approve three leagues in Boys’ Volleyball for 2010-11, with all teams with a .500 or better league record qualifying for the tournament. The teams will be bracketed by classification and compete to determine the Class A and Class B qualifiers for the NYSPHSAA tournament.

- B. **Policy** – The Policy Committee met on Tuesday, February 9, 2010, at 9 am, at the Section XI office. In attendance: Chair M. A. Jules; Conference I: T. Combs, D. Cronin; Conference II: T. Horan, W. Groth; Conference III: J. Tasman, L. Lally; Conference IV: K. Kunst, R. Mayo. Also in attendance: E. Cinelli. (Absent: R. Roche)

The Committee recommends approval of the following for 2010-11:

1. Football
 - a. Sport Season/Starting Dates – “Shall the start date for the 2010-11 varsity, junior varsity and JV9 football be no earlier than Monday, August 16, 2010.” (Current start date by policy for football is Thursday, August 19, 2010.)

NOTE: The Committee also recommends that the earliest possible scheduled game may be Tuesday, September 7, 2010, for schools that are unable to practice during the Rosh Hashanah Holy Days (Smithtown, Half Hollow Hills, Hauppauge and Ward Melville). All other games will be scheduled for Saturday, September 11, 2010.

- b. Team Drops – “Shall the following changes be approved for the 2010-11 football season:

10. If one team drops in a division, it will be a forfeit.

11. If two teams drop in any Division prior to August 1, 2010, a new schedule will be developed.”

Current Policy:

~~10. If any team drops out on or before the Tuesday after Labor Day, that team's Division will reschedule according to approved schedules for 11, 12 or 13 teams. (revised 3/14/06)~~

~~11. Should any division drop below 11 teams on or before the Tuesday after Labor Day, a complete realignment of all Section XI divisions must take place.~~

~~12. If a team drops out after the Tuesday after Labor Day, all schedules and divisions will remain intact. All games scheduled against a team that has dropped out after the Tuesday after Labor Day will be considered forfeit. (revised 3/14/06)~~

~~13. If a team starts late (due to budget problems) or doesn't complete its schedule, but plays any part of its schedule, the games played will count and any unplayed games will be forfeited to the opposing schools.~~

2. Misconduct Policy – “Shall the following changes to C. Penalties, 2. Players and Coaches, b. Removal From a Subsequent Contest be approved: A player or coach suspended from a contest due to misconduct exhibited prior to a contest, or ejected from a contest for misconduct occurring during the contest, or a player or coach guilty of misconduct following a contest is not to participate in his/her team's regularly scheduled contest (including post-season contests). If a suspended player or coach participates in the contest, he/she is deemed ineligible and that contest is considered forfeited. **If a suspended coach is in attendance at the contest, he/she is deemed ineligible and the contest considered forfeited.”**

NOTE: “Not being physically present at the site” means the disqualified coach is not present in the locker room, on the sidelines, in the stands or site area before, during or after the game/meet. (*NYSPPHSAA Eligibility Standard #27 Sportsmanship*)

- C. Modified** – The Modified Committee met on Tuesday, February 10, 2009, at 11 am, at the Section XI office. In attendance: Co-Chairs D. Robinson and G. McCarthy; Conference I: J. Thode, G. Beutel; Conference II: T. Horan, J. Pennacchio; Conference III: M. DeVincenzo, J. Tasman; Conference IV: D. Ferry, G. Ruppert. Also in attendance: J. Wright, J. Sexton and E. Cinelli.

The Committee recommends approval of the following for 2009-10:

1. Boys' and Girls' Spring Track - "Shall the 1500m Run replace the 1600m Run in both boys' and girls' modified spring track". (This will allow a participant to run 1500m and 800m at a meet.)

NOTE: A student may enter a maximum of three events per day, no more than two track events or two field events may be entered each day. If a student is participating in two running events, the total distance may not exceed 2300 meters (total distance refers to specific events, not total distance of heats). A student is limited to one running event if the distance of that exceeds 2300 meters."

2. Try Out Period

"Shall a late winter 7th or 8th grade student-athlete be permitted to try out for a high school spring sport under Selection Classification according to the NYSPHSAA/Section XI try-out period listed below and be permitted to return to the Modified Late Winter sport if the student does not make the high school team."

NYSPHSAA/Section XI Try Out Period:

II. Try-outs

A trial period shall be allowed which permits exceptional athletes at the modified level to try-out with a varsity and/or a junior varsity team for a period not to exceed the number of days listed below. A participant whose try-out period exceeds the limit will be disqualified from further participation in that modified sport during that school year.

NOTES/REMINDERS:

1. 2009-10 Spring Modified Schedule - J. Sexton provided a draft of the spring 2009-10 schedules.
2. Girls' Lacrosse - Teams shall be divided into two squads of equal numbers and UNEQUAL ability. The stronger squad (A) will play the first and third periods, and the weaker squad (B) will play the second and fourth periods. All players are eligible for the fifth period.
3. Softball - A maximum of ten players may bat in one inning per team. If three outs are recorded prior to the tenth batter appearing, the following inning will begin with the next batter scheduled to bat (Example: Batter 5 makes the third out; Batter 6 leads off the next inning, and the inning will end with Batter 5 if three outs have not been recorded.) If the third out is made as a result of any play not involving a batted ball or strikeout, then that batter will lead off the next inning (ASA book rule).
