**II. REPORTS****A. Executive Board**

The Executive Board met on Monday, March 1, 2010, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI office. In attendance: President R. Goldin, M.A. Jules, J. Thode, P. Nickerson, J. Dolan, L. Light, K. Seaman, J. Sexton and E. Cinelli. (Absent: L. Lally, N. DeCillis, L. Schwartz, A. Annunziato, and P. Sullivan-Kriss)

1. President – Ross Goldin called the meeting to order at 4:06 pm.
2. Sport Chair Appointment - Ross Goldin announced the appointment of Tom Combs as the Section XI Football Chair.
3. NYSPHSAA - Paula Nickerson  
Paula Nickerson reviewed the minutes of the January 21, 2010 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee conference call meeting. At the meeting the Executive Committee approved the 2010-11 NYSPHSAA Classifications as follows:
  - Girls' Volleyball (variation) - Class AA: 1040-up; Class A: 690-1039; Class B: 436-689; Class C: 256-435; Class D: 255-below.
  - Boys' and Girls' Cross Country (variation) - Class AA: 1025-up; Class A: 645-1024; Class B: 425-644; Class C: 256-424; Class D: 255-below.
  - Field Hockey (remains the same) - Class A: 915-up; Class B: 914-450; Class C: 449-below.
  - Boys' Lacrosse (variation) - Class A: 1050-up; Class B: 650-1049; Class C/D: 649-below.
  - Girls' Lacrosse (variation) - Class A: 1050-up; Class B: 675-1049; Class C: 674-below.
  - Boys' Volleyball (variation) - Class A: 1000-up; Class B: 999-below.
4. Counsel – Kevin Seaman
  - A. Mr. Seaman led a discussion regarding the Stony Brook School's failure to provide a competitive boys' basketball team during the February 28, 2010 Section XI tournament quarter-final game vs. Wyandanch. After lengthy discussion, Executive Director Ed Cinelli will send a letter to the Stony Brook School Athletic Director, Kevin Kunst, voicing the displeasure of the Section.
  - B. Mr. Seaman informed the Board of correspondence received from the State of New York Department of Labor regarding the independent contractor status of our officials. Periodically we receive letters from the Department of Labor regarding this issue and have provided essential documentation that has been accepted by the Department.
5. Treasurer – Larry Light  
Mr. Light highlighted Section XI's Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2009-February 24, 2010.
6. President – Ross Goldin  
Mr. Goldin provided the Board with the Internal Auditor's report for January 2010.
7. Executive Board Openings 2010-11  
The Executive Director announced there are two openings beginning 2010-11 on the Executive Board: 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President. Information will be provided to member schools regarding these openings.
8. Tax-Exempt Status  
Section XI received correspondence from the Internal Revenue Service that has determined that we have received tax-exempt status from Federal income taxes.

9. Awards Dinner Costs  
The Executive Director provided the Board with a graph reflecting the costs that coaches' associations charge student-athletes, parents, and coaches to attend their annual awards dinners. The Executive Director has sent correspondence to the presidents of the coaches' associations asking that they work in consultation with Section XI sport chairs to consider cutting costs to attend these functions.
10. Misconduct  
The Executive Director provided information to the Board regarding an incident where a wrestler made contact with an official during a match. The school dismissed the athlete from the team and had made arrangements for a hearing with the student-athlete, his parents, and coaches should the student decide to try out for a team during the 2010-11 school year.
11. OMNI Group  
The Board approved a price quote from OMNI Group for the 2010-11 school year.
12. Fingerprinting  
The Executive Director provided correspondence from New York State Education Department representatives, Trish Kocialski and Deb Marriott (OSPRA) regarding interpretation of SAVE Legislation on fingerprinting for officials. Section XI requires all officials to be fingerprinted prior to receiving assignments.
13. Section XI Quarterly Expenses  
The Executive Director provided the Board with the Meals and Refreshments expense form for the period of January 4, 2010 to February 27, 2010.
14. Assistant Director Applications  
The Executive Director announced that 35 applications have been received for the Section XI Assistant Director position. Application screening will take place during the week of March 8, 2010, with interviews to follow.
15. Safety Committee Report  
The Executive Director provided a synopsis of the February 24, 2010, Safety Committee meeting. Discussion took place at this meeting with respect to the Section providing guidelines to member schools regarding concussion management.
16. Boys' Basketball  
Discussion took place regarding an incident at a boys' basketball game which was suspended due to fan interruption. The game was continued the following day. Suspended players from that contest were not permitted to play in that contest nor the following game.
17. Ineligible Boys' Basketball Player  
The Executive Director provided the Board with correspondence from an athletic administrator indicating that the last game of the regular season was forfeited by the school due to the participation of an ineligible player.
18. Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP  
The Executive Board approved the engagement letter with the accounting firm of Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The accounting firm will also prepare Section XI's IRS form 990 - *Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax* for the year ending June 30, 2010.

19. Misconduct

The Executive Director provided correspondence from a member district that admitted there was contact initiated by a student-athlete to an official.

**B. NYSPHSAA Executive Committee** – N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson

At its January 31, 2010 meeting (via conference call), the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:

1. Winter Track – Approved a reduction in the number of required contests from 6 to 4 in Boys' and Girls' Winter Track in Sections I, VI, VIII, IX, X and XI.
2. Sport Coordinators – Approved the appointment of Peter Hugo as Boys' Swimming and Diving State Coordinator effective through August 31, 2013.
3. State Championships – Approved the following:
  - Boys' Soccer State Championships in 2010 and 2011 to be held at Middletown High School (Sec IX).
  - Boys' and Girls' Spring Track State Championships in 2011 to be held at Caledonia-Mumford (Sec V).
  - Baseball State Championships in 2011, 2012 and 2013 to be held at Binghamton (Sec IV).
4. Classifications – Approved the following:
  - Girls' Volleyball (variation) - Class AA: 1040-up; Class A: 690-1039; Class B: 436-689; Class C: 256-435; Class D: 255-below.
  - Boys' and Girls' Cross Country (variation) - Class AA: 1025-up; Class A: 645-1024; Class B: 425-644; Class C: 256-424; Class D: 255-below.
  - Field Hockey (remains the same) – Class A: 915-up; Class B: 914-450; Class C: 449-below.
  - Boys' Lacrosse (variation) – Class A: 1050-up; Class B: 650-1049; Class C/D: 649-below.
  - Girls' Lacrosse (variation) – Class A: 1050-up; Class B: 675-1049; Class C: 674-below.
  - Boys' Volleyball (variation) – Class A: 1000-up; Class B: 999-below.
  - Tabled a motion for an annual review of Classification numbers and Classification Variation numbers at the December Executive Committee meeting.

**C. Counsel** – Kevin Seaman

1. Mr. Seaman commented on The Stony Brook School's lack of providing a competitive boys' basketball team to play Wyandanch at the February 28, 2010, Section XI tournament game. Executive Director Ed Cinelli has sent correspondence to Kevin Kunst, Stony Brook Athletic Director, regarding this matter.
2. Mr. Seaman commented on correspondence the Section received from the New York State Department of Labor regarding the "Independent Contractor" status of officials. No further action is needed at this time.

**D. NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy Committee** – Lisa Lally

Ms. Lally provided the Athletic Council with an update on the progress of the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy Committee. The Committee has reviewed NYSPHSAA qualifying procedures for Section participation in individual sports. No final recommendations have been developed. However, Ms. Lally feels confident that this Committee will make some strong recommendations to the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee regarding qualification standards.

**III. NYSPHSAA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION**

- A. Wrestling – “Shall the 96 lb. and 285 lb. weight classes be mandatory for all high school competitions – Duals and Tournaments – beginning with the 2010-11 season.”

Conference Response: There were mixed feelings among the Conferences regarding this proposal for mandating the 96 lb. weight class, as many of these student-athletes are 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders participating under selection classification.

- B. Field Hockey – “Shall there be a waiver of the solid white/dark shirts for the 2010 Fall season (only if needed).”

Conference Response: In favor

- C. Baseball – “Shall, by mutual agreement of the Section’s Executive Directors, Section Coordinators and Athletic Directors, schools have the option of playing Monday scheduled regional games on Sunday.” Rationale: This would allow for better facilities, potential for bigger crowds, and less time out of school.

Conference Response: In favor

- D. Girls’ Lacrosse – “Shall, in games when 100% playing time is required (all Sectional, Regional and State Semi-Finals and Finals), the game be resumed from the point of interruption on the next available date. Teams that have possession at the point of interruption will retain possession in a draw alignment with the opposing center 4 meters away. If there is no team possession, it will be a draw.”

Conference Response: In favor

- E. Girls’ and Boys’ Tennis – “Shall, in Sectional competition, Sections have the option to increase the number of matches to four in one day using modified scoring. The rest periods would be 30 minutes for the quarter final and below, 45 minutes for the semi-finals, and 60 minutes for the finals.” (The committees would like to take this proposal to the Safety Committee. The Boys Committee would like to have approval for the regular season as well.)

Conference Response: In favor

- F. Foreign Exchange – International Students – “Shall the criteria regarding Foreign Exchange and International Students be updated.”

Conference Response – In favor

- G. Conducting a Contest – Charity and Fundraising – “Shall the criteria regarding a contest or game being held in conjunction with a fund raising effort be updated.”

Conference Response – In favor

- H. Definition of a Scrimmage – “Shall the establishment of sport-specific criteria for scrimmages be considered.”

Conference Response – Much discussion took place regarding the sport-specific criteria for scrimmages. Although the Conferences were in favor of such criteria, there was a feeling that the sport-specific scrimmage criteria left no options for schools that may participate in scrimmages in and out of New York.
