II. REPORTS**A. Executive Board**

The Section XI Executive Board met on Monday, May 3, 2010, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President M.A. Jules, J. Thode, L. Lally, N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson, L. Schwartz, P. Sullivan-Kriss, L. Light, D. Webster, J. Sexton and E. Cinelli. (Absent: A. Annunziato, J. Dolan, K. Seaman)

1. President - President Mary Anne Jules called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm.
2. Internal Claims Auditor - Mary Anne Jules and Ed Cinelli reviewed the March 26, 2010 and April 30, 2010 Internal Claims Auditor report from Helen Maloney. The Executive Board directed Ed Cinelli to make payments to the Section XI attorney after services have been rendered.
3. Tournament Committee Chair - The Executive Board approved Tom Combs as the Section XI Tournament Committee chair, replacing Wayne Shierant who has retired.
4. Appointment of Assistant Director - The Executive Board appointed Donald F. Webster as the Section XI Assistant Director, replacing John C. Sexton who will retire on June 30, 2010. The Executive Director reviewed with the Board the Assistant Director Working Agreement that involves salaries, benefit money and health insurance options for the 10-month employees for the period September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
5. NYSPHSAA Report (April 30-May 1, 2010) - Paula Nickerson/Nick DeCillis
Nick DeCillis and Paula Nickerson reviewed with the Executive Board items that were approved at the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting on April 30/May 1, 2010. A detailed report will be distributed to the member schools when it is finalized by the NYSPHSAA office staff.
6. Nick DeCillis Hall of Fame Induction - The Executive Board congratulated Nick DeCillis for being selected for induction into the NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame. The induction ceremony will take place at the NYSPHSAA Central Committee meeting on August 4, 2010, at the Holiday Valley Resort in Ellicottville, New York.
7. Championship Philosophy Report - Lisa Lally provided an overview of the recommendations of the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy Committee. Ms. Lally will present this report to the Section XI Athletic Directors at their May 19, 2010 meeting.
8. Treasurer - Larry Light reviewed with the Executive Board the Profit and Loss vs. Actual for the period July 1, 2009 through April 28, 2010.
9. MSG Contract - The Executive Director provided the Board with a proposed license agreement for the 2010-11 school year. This item will be reviewed by the Section XI attorney Kevin Seaman and will be discussed at the May 18, 2010, Executive Board meeting.
10. Misconduct - The Executive Director updated the Board regarding the actions of a varsity baseball coach from a member school. Lynn Schwartz will discuss this matter with the Superintendent from the school.

11. Nominating Committee - The Nominating Committee recommends the following slate for 2010-11:

12. Staff Health Insurance - The Executive Board approved the staff health insurance with Oxford Metro beginning June 1, 2010, replacing the Empire plan.
13. Safety Committee Report on Concussion Management - The Executive Board discussed possible guidelines for member schools regarding concussion management. This item will be reviewed by the Section XI attorney.
14. Section XI Quarterly Expenses: Meals and Refreshments - The Executive Director provided the Executive Board with the meals and refreshments expenses for the period March 1, 2010 through May 9, 2010.
15. Oaktree Systems, Inc. - The Executive Board approved a two-year agreement commencing July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012, with Oaktree Systems, Inc. The Board recommends that the Executive Director survey Section XI athletic directors for recommendations on how the computer system could better serve the member-schools.
16. Cullen & Danowski, LLP Accounting Firm - The Executive Director reviewed with the Board an e-mail he received from Deirdre Lunetta of Cullen & Danowski, LLP. The e-mail identifies Section XI as classified as a 503c3 by the IRS.
17. Stony Brook University - The Executive Director announced that an agreement has been made with Stony Brook University to host the 2011 Section XI wrestling championships.
18. Section XI Website Advertising - The Executive Board approved a fee of \$150 per month to be charged to advertisers on the Section XI website during the 2010-11 school year.
19. Section XI Boys' Basketball Playoffs - The Executive Director supplied the Board with information regarding two incidents at boys' basketball playoffs contests that involved security and athletic trainers. The Executive Director praised the cooperation of security and medical staffs for the response to emergencies during the boys' basketball playoffs.
20. Executive Director Goals and Objectives - The Executive Director presented a final report on his goals and objectives for the 2009-10 school year. He also provided a draft of his goals and objectives for 2010-11.
21. Section XI Holy Day Policy - The Executive Director provided correspondence he received from a member school regarding the Section XI Holy Day policy restrictions.

22. Section XI Tentative 2010-11 Calendar - The Executive Director provided a copy of the Section XI tentative calendar for 2010-11.
 23. NYSPPHSAA Intent to Participate - The Executive Director provided a copy of the NYSPPHSAA Intent to Participate form that was submitted to the state.
 24. Gate Receipts History - The Executive Director provided a chart comparing the gate receipts for boys' basketball, girls' basketball and wrestling from the 2002-03 school year through the 2009-10 school year.
 25. Section XI State Championship Expenses - The Executive Director provided a chart indicating state championship expenses from the 1997-98 school year through the 2009-10 school year.
 26. Fall 2009-10 Modified Team Participation - The Executive Director provided a chart highlighting the change in number of modified teams from the fall 2009 season to the fall 2010 season.
 27. Outside Agencies - The Executive Board approved the Executive Director's recommendation of the following outside agencies, allowing them to conduct track and field meets:
 - April 10, 2010: Suffolk Officials Track & Field meet at Mt. Sinai HS
 - April 17, 2010: Suffolk Coaches Track & Field meet at Bay Shore HS
 - May 15, 2010: Elks Invitational Modified Track & Field meet at Comsewogue HS
 28. Softball Official - The Executive Director provided information to the Board regarding the actions of a softball official. It is alleged that this official made inappropriate comments to student-athletes during a contest. Assistant Director Jack Sexton has communicated with the Suffolk County Softball Officials Association, and an agreement has been made by this Association and Section XI to suspend the official until a thorough investigation can take place.
- B. **NYSPPHSAA Executive Committee** - Nick DeCillis, Paula Nickerson
At its April 30-May 1, 2010 meeting, the NYSPPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:
1. 2010-11 Championships
 - Approved the updated schedule of known dates/sites for 2010-11.
 - Approved Section participation in 2010-11 NYSPPHSAA Championships and Regionals as per NYSPPHSAA Constitution, Article V, #5.
 2. Pre-Season Practices - Approved the change in the Pre-Season Practice Regulation from 3-2-6-4 to 2-3-6-4 for high school teams in Football.
 3. Jewelry Rule - Approved continuing to use the 2009-10 NCAA Jewelry Rule to replace Rule 7.2.3 of the NCAA 2010-11 rule in Boys' and Girls' Volleyball.
 4. Boys' and Girls' Swimming - Approved to continue for 2010-11 to use the criteria established for the qualifying standards in Boys' and Girls' Swimming.

5. Wrestling
 - Approved in Wrestling the 96 lb. and 285 lb. weight class will be mandatory for all high school competitions, duals and tournaments beginning with the 2010-11 season.
 - Approved all wrestlers will be certified at a minimum weight rather than a minimum weight class for 2010-11 and 2011-12.
6. Baseball – Approved in Baseball with mutual agreement of the Section’s Executive Directors, Section Coordinators and Athletic Directors, schools would have the option of playing Monday scheduled regional games on Sunday.
7. Girls’ Lacrosse – Approved in Girls’ Lacrosse in games when 100% playing time is required (all Sectional, Regional and State Semi-Finals and Finals) the game will be resumed from the point of interruption on the next available date.
8. Boys’ and Girls’ Tennis – Approved in Boys’ and Girls’ Tennis in league and Sectional competition, Sections would have the option to increase the number of matches to four in one day using modified scoring.
9. Scholar/Athlete Program – Approved in 2010-11 teams that play sports outside of that sport’s championship season may be recognized as a Scholar/Athlete team if they meet the program’s criteria.
10. Championship Tickets – Approved to add a \$1 convenience fee to all championship tickets sold on-line by TicketLeap beginning with the Spring 2010 championships.
11. 2010-11 Budget – Approved the 2010-11 budget.
12. Modified Sports
 - Football – Approved with Sectional approval, schools will be allowed to use two wide receivers on opposite sides of the formation in Modified Football.
 - Wrestling -
 - a) Approved in Modified Wrestling with Sectional/League approval, modified wrestlers who compete in two or three bouts in a contest, the time periods are either: Three 1-minute periods; or 1st period – 1 minute, 2nd and 3rd periods – 1½ minutes.
 - b) Approved with Sectional approval, an additional sudden victory overtime period shall be permitted in Modified Wrestling. Wrestlers must start in the standing position, and the period shall not exceed 30 seconds.
 - Baseball/Softball – Approved in Modified Baseball/Softball, with Sectional/League approval, when the team at bat has two (2) outs with the catcher on base, a pinch runner may be used to allow the catcher to get his/her gear on prior to the third out.
 - Number of Games – Approved due to current fiscal concerns in New York State, with Sectional/League approval, up to 50% of the maximum number of games permitted for each modified level sport may be designated as scrimmages during the 2010-11 and 2011-12 school years.
13. Officiating Fees – Approved the 2009-10 officiating fees and policy changes be extended to the 2010-11 school year.
14. Heat Index/Wind Chill Procedures – Approved the Heat Index and Wind Chill Procedures for all member schools to follow during the regular season and post season play effective Spring 2010.

15. Practice Regulation – Approved a Practice Regulation regarding athletes who switch from a contact/collision or limited contact/impact sport to a strenuous/non-contact or non-strenuous/non-contact sport.
 16. Scrimmages – Approved the Handbook Committee’s recommendations pertaining to interschool scrimmages, nights rest between scrimmages, and scrimmage limitations per day.
 17. Foreign Exchange/International Student
 - Approved definitions for Foreign Exchange and International Student.
 - Approved the new Foreign Exchange and International Student regulation.
 18. Conducting a Contest – Approved the addition of language under Conducting a Contest to help clarify how a regular season contest must be contested when held in conjunction with a fund raising event.
 19. Sportsmanship Standard
 - Approved a language change to the Sportsmanship rule to state, “...disqualified by a sport official...”.
 - Approved the Handbook Committee’s penalty recommendation for a coach that does not serve the penalty for violating the Sportsmanship Standard.

- C. **NYSPHSAA Assistant Director** – Robert Stulmaker
1. Mr. Stulmaker announced that the Cheerleading Clinic has been scheduled for this Friday, May 21st in Fishkill; and the Soccer Clinic has been schedule for June 14th in Utica.
 2. Mr. Stulmaker reviewed with the Athletic Council the new regulations that will affect interschool scrimmages. These regulations will be disseminated fro the NYSPHSAA office and will be forwarded to school districts by the end of the school year.
 3. Mr. Stulmaker reviewed with the Athletic Council the new NYSPHSAA sportsmanship language that states that any coach who does not serve the penalty for violating the Sportsmanship Standard #27, is ineligible to coach until the next two regularly scheduled contests are completed.
- D. **Counsel** – Kevin Seaman
1. Mr. Seaman discussed with the Athletic Council the Section XI misconduct policy as it relates to procedures involving disciplinary action taken against a varsity softball coach for allegedly having physical contact with an official and violating a NYSPHSAA regulation.
 2. Mr. Seaman reviewed with the Athletic Council the Section XI procedure to only hear appeals from member school districts, not individuals.

- B. "Shall a minimum weight of 67 pounds be established to wrestle in the 74 pound weight class." (Pending approval of NYSPHSAA Modified and Executive Committees.)
- C. "Shall a 165 pound weight class be added." (Pending approval of NYSPHSAA Modified and Executive Committees.)
- D. "Shall a modified wrestler be permitted to wrestle one weight class above his/her actual weight." (Pending approval of NYSPHSAA Modified and Executive Committees.)

ATTACHMENT C**NYSPHSAA WIND CHILL PROCEDURES**

Administration of Wind Chill Policy:

- Wind Chill will be checked 1 hour before the contest/practice by a certified athletic trainer, athletic director, or school designee when the air temperature is 39 degrees (Fahrenheit) or lower.
- The athletic trainer, athletic director, or school designee will use the accuweather.com website to determine the wind chill index for the area of the contest/practice. The accuweather.com website can be reached through the NYSPHSAA website. Once a person is on the accuweather.com website, they will put in the zip code for the location of the contest/practice and the website will give them the air temperature as well as the *RealFeel* temperature (wind chill).
- If the *RealFeel* temperature (wind chill) is 10 degrees or below, the athletic trainer, athletic director, or school designee must re-check the *RealFeel* (wind chill) at halftime or midway point of the contest. If the *RealFeel* (wind chill) temperature is -11 degrees (Fahrenheit) or lower, the contest will be suspended.

Please refer to the following chart to take the appropriate actions:

	<i>RealFeel</i> (wind chill) above 40 degrees	Full activity. No restrictions
R E C O M M E N D E D	Wind Chill Caution: <i>RealFeel</i> (wind chill) 36 degrees to 20 degrees	Stay adequately hydrated. Notify coaches of the threat of cold-related illnesses. Have students and coaches dress in layers of clothing.
	Wind Chill Watch: <i>RealFeel</i> (wind chill) 29 degrees to 10 degrees	Stay adequately hydrated. Notify coaches of the threat of cold-related illnesses. Have students and coaches dress in layers of clothing. Cover the head and neck to prevent heat loss.
	Wind Chill Warning: <i>RealFeel</i> (wind chill) 9 degrees to -10 degrees	Stay adequately hydrated. Notify coaches of the threat of cold-related illnesses. Have students and coaches dress in layers of clothing. Cover the head and neck to prevent heat loss. Consider postponing practice to a time when <i>RealFeel</i> temperature is much higher. Reduce the amount of time for an outdoor practice session.
REQUIRED	Wind Chill Alert: <i>RealFeel</i> (wind chill) -11 degrees or lower	No outside activity, practice or contest, should be held.

Special note: Alpine skiing will be exempt from this policy and will follow the regulations of the host ski center where the practice is being held.
