B. <u>Scholar-Athlete Teams</u> – The listing of Section XI Scholar-Athlete Teams for the Fall 2010 sports season was distributed to the Athletic Council (Attachment A).

II. REPORTS

A. EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Executive Board met on Monday, January 4, 2010, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President M. A. Jules, J. Thode, J. Polansky, L. Lally, P. Nickerson, N. DeCillis, L. Schwartz, P. Sullivan-Kriss, K. Seaman, L. Light, A. Groveman, D. Webster and E. Cinelli. (Absent: A. Annunziato, J. Dolan)

1. President – Mary Anne Jules called the meeting to order at 4:04 pm.

2. Finance Committee – Alan Groveman

- A. The Section XI Finance Committee Chair, Alan Groveman, reviewed the December 8, 2010 Finance Committee meeting report, including the proposed 2011-12 budget that includes a 2% increase in Dues and Service Charges to Section XI member schools, along with the appropriation of \$285,052 to the budget from the fund balance.
- B. Mr. Groveman commented on the 2009-10 audit and management letter by Cullen & Danowski, LLP.

3. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Larry Light

Mr. Light reviewed the Section XI Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2010 through December 28, 2010, and provided information regarding the income and expenses within that budget period.

4. Counsel - Kevin Seaman

Mr. Seaman reviewed the determination of the Section XI Eligibility Committee regarding an Islip High School student-athlete. It was felt that sufficient evidence was provided to the Eligibility Committee to allow the student-athlete to participate in interscholastic athletics at Islip High School during the 2010-11 school year.

5. Sample Policies - Ed Cinelli

- A. The Executive Board approved a Record Retention Policy for Section XI.
- B. Discussion took place with respect to the adoption of a Conflict of Interest Policy and a Whistleblower Policy. Kevin Seaman will be providing drafts of these policies to the Executive Board at its next meeting.

6. <u>Internal Auditor's Report</u> – Mary Anne Jules

- A. Ms. Jules provided the Executive Board with the Internal Auditor's reports for October 29th, November 30th and December 29th, 2010.
- B. The Internal Auditor has recommended the use of a sign-in attendance sheet to use as backup for bills incurred when meeting expenditures include meals.

7. NYSPSHAA – Nick DeCillis, Paula Nickerson

- A. Paula Nickerson and Nick DeCillis provided a synopsis of the December 5 & 6, 2010, NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting held in Albany and the December 21, 2010 NYSPHSAA Central Committee meeting held via conference call.
- B. NYSPHSAA Office reports for November and December 2010, and January 2011 were provided.

8. <u>Championship Philosophy Committee Update</u> – Lisa Lally

Ms. Lally provided an update of the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy Committee. She reported that the Committee has looked into balancing the number of participants in New York State championships.

- 9. <u>Section XI Rental Costs Comparisons</u> The Executive Director provided an outline of the Section costs to rent facilities during the Fall 2010 championships as well as the income earned from gate receipts at these events.
- 10. <u>Officials' Contract</u> The Executive Director provided information regarding the dual meet fees for varsity wrestling officials when 15 bouts are scheduled. This is a result of the addition of the 96 and 285 pound weight classes.
- 11. <u>Outside Agency Approval</u> The Executive Board retroactively approved the following outside agencies to conduct tournaments within Section XI:
 - ➤ Suffolk County XC Coaches Invitational 9/25/10
 - ➤ Suffolk County XC Officials' Invitational 10/9/10
 - ➤ Suffolk County XC Coaches' Frosh/Soph Meet 10/30/10
 - ➤ Southampton Youth Services Boys' Basketball Tournament 12/17 & 18, 2010
 - Eastern Long Island Boys' Basketball Officials' Holiday Classic 12/ 28 & 29, 2010
- 12. <u>Boys' Basketball Officials' Request</u> The Executive Director provided correspondence from the Presidents of the Eastern and Western Boys' Basketball Officials' Associations regarding three-man officiating at Section XI tournaments. Section XI will not pay for additional officials at Section XI post-season contests.
- 13. <u>Concussion Management</u> The Executive Director provided information regarding his presentation to the Suffolk County School Superintendents' Association at their December 2010 meeting. The presentation included a draft of the NYSPHSAA Concussion Management Policy along with Concussion Management support materials.
- 14. Executive Director Goals and Objectives Mid-Year Report The Executive Director provided the Board with his mid-year report. He also informed the Executive Board that a committee will be developed to look at the Section XI webpage and computer programs with the possibility of adopting an online officials rating system.
- 15. <u>NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame</u> Executive Director Ed Cinelli, and Assistant Director Don Webster, have submitted the application of Boys' Lacrosse coach Joe Cuozzo for induction into the NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame in 2011.
- 16. <u>Section XI Quarterly Expenses</u> The Executive Director provided the Executive Board with the Meals and Refreshment expenses for the period October 4, 2010 through January 2, 2011.
- 17. <u>Cheerleading</u> The Executive Director provided information from Mary Lou Assante, Section XI Cheerleading Representative to the NYSPHSAA regarding Cheerleading.
- 18. <u>NYSPHSAA Code of Conduct Violation</u> The Executive Director reported on a Code of Conduct violation that took place during the state championships involving a Section XI school.
- 19. <u>Basic Conference Placement</u> The Executive Director provided information regarding Basic Conference Placement of Section XI schools for the 2011-12 school year.
- 20. <u>NYSPHSAA Championship Site Proposal Boys' Soccer</u> Section XI, in cooperation with the Town of Brookhaven, has submitted an application to the NYSPHSAA to host the 2012 and 2013 state boys' soccer championships.

- 21. New York State Section Athletic Participation 2009-10 A graph of the 2009-10 school year athletic participation in New York State by Section was provided. It was noted that although Section XI ranks 7th in the number of schools, we rank 1st in the number of student-athletes.
- 22. <u>February 28th Executive Board Meeting</u> Discussion took place regarding a possible date change for the next meeting of the Executive Board.

B. NYSPHSAA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE - N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson

At its December 5-6, 2010 meeting, the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:

- 1. <u>Championship Dates and Sites</u> Approved the 2011-12 proposed championship dates and sites.
- State Sport Coordinator Reappointments Approved the reappointments of the following State Sport Coordinators for a 5-year term, effective September 1, 2011 to August 31, 2016: Dick Cerone, Football; Dan Doherty, Girls' Outdoor Track and Field; Mike Andrew, Boys' Soccer; Cathy Allen, Softball; and Jim Amen, Boys' Lacrosse.
- 3. <u>Enrollment Numbers</u> Approved as official the enrollment numbers presented for 2011-12.
- 4. <u>Championship School Gate List</u> Approved continuing the Championship School Gate List for the 2010 Winter and Spring team championships for all semi-finals and final games.
- 5. <u>Dues Increase</u> Approved adding the dues increase for the 2011-12 school year as an Action Item on the agenda for the December 21, 2010 Central Committee meeting conference call.
- 6. <u>Fiscal Concerns</u> Approved to bring the following for a vote by the Central Committee meeting on December 21, 2010 at 10:30 am: To extend the Fiscal Concerns items (numbers 1-7) for a period of one year (2011-12) with one exception Item 6 will be changed to reinstate the original Executive Committee meeting schedule to October, January and May. The January meeting will be held by conference call.

7. Cheerleading

- Approved beginning in 2011-12, the NYSPHSAA recommends all coaches/ advisors of Cheer (sideline, spirit, competitive) complete the following courses prior to coaching: First Aid for Coaches, CPR, and the AACCA Safety Course.
- Approved the Cheerleading Ad Hoc Committee continues to study cheer and how it would be defined as a sport.
- 8. <u>Academic Hardship Waiver</u> Approved language changes in two sentences in the Academic Hardship Waiver.

9. Basketball

- > Approved Girls' Basketball to follow the NFHS Concussion Rule.
- > Approved a waiver of the orange ball rule in Boys' and Girls' Basketball for the month of February if both teams agree.

10. <u>Wrestling</u> – Approved to waive the 45-minute rule between bouts for wrestlers who receive a forfeit.

11. Softball

- Approved in Softball to adopt the 43' pitching distance for Varsity, Junior Varsity and Freshman levels beginning with the 2011 season.
- Approved the use of metal cleats will be prohibited on all levels of play in Softball.
- Approved in Softball a change in the umpire rotation at the State Semi-Finals and Finals.
- 12. <u>Indoor Track</u> Approved a reduction in the number of required contests from 6 to 4 in Boys' and Girls' Indoor Track in Sections 2, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, and 11.
- 13. <u>Field Hockey</u> Approved a waiver of the field hockey uniform rule change for one year (2011 season).
- 14. <u>Jewelry Rule</u> Approved a waiver of the Jewelry Rule to allow hair restraints in the sports of Track & Field and Cross Country as defined in the sport specific rule book.

15. Concussion Management

- Approved the Concussion Management Model School Policy Draft be shared with our member schools to help them through the concussion management process.
- Approved using the Concussion Management Support Materials developed by the Concussion Management Team.
- 16. <u>"Be Loud, Be Proud, Be Positive" Statement</u> Approved the "Be Loud, Be Proud, Be Positive" statement be read at all NYSPHSAA Championship events.
- 17. <u>Community Service Challenge Award</u> Approved the NYSPHSAA Community Service Challenge Award.

18. Handbook Updates

- Approved adding language to the appeal process for a misidentified player (pg. 104 #3, under Player NYSPHSAA Handbook.
- > Approved changing the term "exempted" to "waiver" when referring to the one transfer without penalty in the Transfer Rule (pg. 106 NYSPHSAA Handbook).
- 19. <u>Modified Baseball/Softball</u> Approved in Modified Baseball/Softball, with Section/League approval, a "mercy rule" will be permitted.
- 20. <u>Modified Girls' Lacrosse</u> Approved Beth Staropoli (Section 3) as the Modified Girls' Lacrosse Sport Coordinator.
- 21. <u>Boys' Lacrosse</u> Approved in Boys' Lacrosse the use of the Chief Bench Official for all NYSPHSAA tournaments.
- 22. <u>Girls' Golf</u> Approved in Girls' Golf to include the PSAL, CHSAA and AISAA in the NYSPHSAA Golf Championships effective 2012.
- 23. <u>Officials' Coordinating Federation</u> Approved to negotiate with the Officials' Coordinating Federation to include the new Fact Finding and Arbitration Process Guidelines in the next OCF agreement.

C. NYSPHSAA CENTRAL COMMITTEE – N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson, E. Cinelli*, M. A. Jules** (*Proxy for L. Schwartz; **Proxy for J. Dolan)
At its meeting on December 21, 2010, via phone conference, the NYSPHSAA Central Committee effected the following:

- 1. <u>Fiscal Concerns</u> Approved one-year extension of Fiscal Concerns Items #1-7 with one exception: Item #6 will be changed to reinstate the original Executive Committee meeting scheduled to October, January and May. The January meeting will be held by conference call.
- **2.** <u>Dues</u> Approved a dues increase of \$30 per school district and \$.03 per student for the 2011-12 school year.

D. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR - Nina Van Erk

- 1. <u>Concussion Management</u> Ms. Van Erk announced that the NYSPHSAA has approved a draft of the NYSPHSAA Concussion Management policy along with concussion management support materials.
- 2. <u>Pink Basketballs</u> Ms. Van Erk outlined the procedure for the approval to use a pink basketball during contests in support of breast cancer research.
- 3. <u>Uniform Rule</u> Ms. Van Erk announced that the NFHS has delayed the implementation of the soccer uniform rule regarding solid white uniform tops from the Fall 2012 to the Fall 2013 season. Additionally, there has been a waiver of the NFHS field hockey uniform rule for one year (2011 season).
- 4. <u>Fiscal Concerns</u> Ms. Van Erk discussed the approval of the fiscal concerns for the 2011-12 school year.
- 5. <u>Committee Updates</u> Ms. Van Erk updated the Athletic Council on the progress made by the NYSPHSAA Cheerleading Committee and the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy Committee.

E. **COUNSEL** – Kevin Seaman

- 1. Mr. Seaman updated the Athletic Council regarding the approval of a waiver of the transfer rule for a student-athlete playing basketball during the 2010-11 school year.
- 2. Mr. Seaman announced to the Athletic Council that there will be a fact-finding hearing regarding a wrestling incident involving two member schools.
