

- C. **Scholar-Athlete Teams** – The listing of Section XI Scholar-Athlete Teams for the Spring 2011 sports season was distributed to the Athletic Council (Attachment A). President Jules congratulated those school teams for their achievement.

II. **REPORTS**

A. **Executive Board**

The Executive Board met on Monday, October 3, 2011, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President M. A. Jules, J. Thode, L. Lally, N. DeCillis, A. Annunziato, P. Sullivan-Kriss, A. Gerstenlauer, K. Seaman, L. Light; D. Lunetta (Items 1-3); H. Maloney (Items 1-2); D. Webster and E. Cinelli. (Absent: J. Polansky and J. Dolan).

1. President – Mary Anne Jules called the meeting to order at 4:06 pm.
2. Internal Claims Auditor
 - A. Section XI Internal Claims Auditor Helen Maloney reviewed with the Board the annual report that she submitted on October 3, 2011. Ms. Maloney noted in her report that officials are now only required to submit the last four digits of their Social Security numbers on claim forms for security purposes.
 - B. Ms. Maloney continues to feel that the Association should establish procedures to have the Treasurer sign all checks and that the President should be alternate signer.
 - C. Ms. Maloney once again voiced her concern regarding the distribution of checks that are to be cashed by the Executive Director that provide meal money for student-athletes who participate in state championships.
3. Cullen & Danowski, LLP – Deirdre Lunetta
 - A. Deirdre Lunetta from the accounting firm of Cullen & Danowski, LLP, commented on Internal Claim Auditor Helen Maloney's report regarding Section XI check signing procedures. Ms. Lunetta was satisfied with the current procedures that are in place in Section XI regarding check signing and feels it is not necessary to have the Treasurer sign checks on a regular basis.
 - B. Ms. Lunetta reviewed the draft of the management letter and the financial statements for the year ended June 30, 2011 and 2010 for the period ending June 30, 2011. She recommends that Section XI consider increasing the amounts billed to member districts so that revenues cover current operating costs for the near future. The goal would be to maintain the current net asset amounts due to uncertainty over future participation and the pressures on member school districts' future budgets.
4. Treasurer – Lawrence Light
 - A. Mr. Light reviewed the Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. He outlined the income and expenses for the Section, providing information on financial issues that the Section must address in future budgets.
5. Counsel – Kevin Seaman
 - A. Unemployment Insurance – Mr. Seaman discussed unemployment insurance filings by officials and unemployment insurance benefits currently being collected by a former employee of Section XI.
 - B. Fingerprinting – Denial of Clearance – A discussion took place regarding an official who was denied clearance and is looking to appeal the decision. After an investigation by the Executive Director, the official was informed that any appeal

should be directed to the Office of School Personnel Review and Accountability (OSPRA) and not Section XI.

- C. SED Fingerprinting of Sports Officials – A letter dated September 23, 2011, from Deborah A. Marriott of the State Education Department, regarding the fingerprinting of sports officials was reviewed with the Executive Board. A discussion took place regarding this correspondence which outlines issues involving “grandfathering” officials and the “5-visit limitation”, which allows an official who is expected to have no more than five days of contact with a covered school to be exempt from fingerprinting. Section XI’s policy requires **ALL** officials to be fingerprinted and cleared by OSPRA in order to officiate. Section XI has **NOT** allowed officials to be “grandfathered” to avoid fingerprinting.

6. Finances

- A. The Executive Board approved the following:
- Contractual items, with the exception of Coastal Charter Services (more information to be requested prior to approval);
 - Leasing/service agreement continuations;
 - Reinstatement of credit card policy with the spending limit of \$5,000 per purchase and a credit line not to exceed \$10,000.
- B. The Executive Director provided the Section XI Meal and Refreshment Quarterly Report for the period between May 2, 2011 and October 2, 2011.
- C. The Executive Director provided a report of Section XI Petty Cash Fund expenditures for the period between October 2, 2010 and October 2, 2011.

7. Appointments

- A. The Executive Board approved the following:
- Sport Chairs for the 2011-12 school year;
 - Committee Chairs for the 2011-12 school year;
 - Conference attendance authorization for the 2011-12 school year;
 - Reappointment of Helen Maloney as Internal Claims Auditor for the 2012-13 through 2015-16 school years at a rate of \$45 per hour.

8. NYSPHSAA – Nick DeCillis, Lisa Lally, Ed Cinelli (proxy for John Dolan), Don Webster (proxy for Patricia Sullivan-Kriss)

- A. Central Committee – Nick DeCillis and Lisa Lally provided information to the Executive Board regarding the August 2-4, 2011, NYSPHSAA Central Committee meeting that was held in Lake Placid. Highlights of the meeting included the approval of the qualifying times for boys’ and girls’ swimming, and the reclassification of cross country from five to four classes. Additionally, information was provided regarding wrestling weight classes and the minimum weight required for selectively classified wrestlers to participate in high school wrestling. Furthermore, discussion took place regarding the approved two-year freeze on the dollar amount paid on dues for 2011-12 for the 2012-13 and 2013-14 school years.
- B. NYSPHSAA Sponsorship Package Proposal – Discussion took place regarding the possibility of the NYSPHSAA pursuing sponsorships for state championships. The Executive Board felt that it would be acceptable for the state and/or Section to permit sponsor packages.
- C. NYS Education Department Update – Lisa Lally provided an overview of the report given by Trish Kocialski in which she outlined the working being done on reviewing Selection Classification.

- D. NYSPPHSAA Hall of Fame – The Section is very pleased that Joe Cuzzo, boys' lacrosse coach at Ward Melville and Mount Sinai high schools was inducted into the NYSPPHSAA Hall of Fame this past August.
9. NYSPPHSAA Office Reports – The Executive Director provided copies of the June, September and October 2011 NYSPPHSAA Office Reports to the Executive Board.
10. NYSPPHSAA Eligible Voting Members – The Executive Board approved Ed Cinelli, Don Webster and Mary Anne Jules as being eligible to serve as proxies from Section XI at NYSPPHSAA meetings for 2011-12.
11. NYSPPHSAA Scholar-Athlete Schools of Distinction – The Executive Director provided correspondence from the NYSPPHSAA naming Commack High School and Bishop McGann-Mercy High School as recipients of the 2010-11 Scholar/Athlete Team Schools of Distinction. This honor is being bestowed on these schools by virtue of the fact that each of their varsity interscholastic athletic teams qualified in the NYSPPHSAA Scholar/Athlete Team Award Program, earning a 90% GPA or better during the past school year. These schools will be honored at the October 12, 2011, Athletic Council meeting.
12. Outside Agency Cross Country Meets – The Executive Board approved the following Outside Agency cross country meets:
- Suffolk Coaches Invitational – September 24, 2011
 - Suffolk Officials Invitational – October 15, 2011
13. Goals and Objectives – The Executive Director provided his goals and objectives for the 2011-12 school year.
14. Wrestling Infectious Diseases Workshop – The Executive Director announced that the Section will be conducting a Wrestling Infectious Diseases Workshop on October 21, 2011. Dr. Bruce J. Anderson from the Boynton Health Service at the University of Minnesota will be providing information regarding the education, prevention and identification of infectious skin diseases, particularly as they relate to wrestling.
15. Officials Fees – Nick DeCillis and Ed Cinelli provided the Executive Board with information regarding the contract Section XI has with the officials' associations. The Executive Board provided direction regarding this item.
16. Section XI Dues and Service Charges/Loss of Teams – Assistant Director Don Webster provided the Executive Board with an outline of the number of teams that have been eliminated by districts due to budget cuts. As of October 3, 2011, 128 teams have been lost, resulting in \$20,889.60 in service charges that the Section will not receive during the 2011-12 school year. This number does not include the potential loss of teams for the spring modified season.
17. Use of Facilities – Stony Brook University – The Executive Board had a lengthy discussion regarding the costs involved in renting Stony Brook University for Section XI championships. Ed Cinelli informed the Board that a meeting will take place to discuss this item with the athletic administrators from Stony Brook University.
18. Verizon FiOS1 TV Broadcasting Rights – Ed Cinelli provided correspondence from Verizon FiOs1 TV. He will contact Verizon representative Orlando Martinez and provide him with information regarding the "Request for Proposal" (RFP) process. Section XI will review this process in March.

19. Ross/Shelter Island Combinings – Correspondence was provided regarding the combining issues with The Ross School and Shelter Island.
20. The Ross School Tennis Academy – A letter from NYSPHSAA Executive Director Nina Van Erk was provided to the Executive Board regarding The Ross School Tennis Academy. Ms. Van Erk, as the official interpreter of the NYSPHSAA Rules and Regulations, states that, “any student enrolled in the Ross School Tennis Academy will be ineligible to practice or compete with The Ross School’s interscholastic tennis team.”
21. Mixed Competition – The Executive Director provided a report regarding the approval of a male student-athlete participating on a field hockey team.
22. NYSPHSAA Championship Dates/Sites – The Executive Director provided the Board with information regarding the 2011-12 NYSPHSAA Championship Dates and Sites.

B. NYSPHSAA Central Committee – N. DeCillis, L. Lally, E. Cinelli*, D. Webster**
(*Proxy for J. Dolan; **Proxy for P. Sullivan-Kriss)

At its annual meeting on August 2-4, 2011, at the High Peaks Resort, Lake Placid, the NYSPHSAA Central Committee effected the following:

1. Sport Seasons - Approved the 2011-12 Section Sport Seasons with the addition of Section IV’s Modified dates.
2. State Championships - Approved 2010-11 State Championship site changes in the sports of Girls’ Gymnastics and Boys’ & Girls’ Bowling.
3. B/G Swimming & Diving
 - Approved Scott Warner (Sec IX) as Boys’ Swimming & Diving Assistant State Coordinator.
 - Approved the Boys’ and Girls’ Swimming and Diving Qualifying Times for the 2011-12 State Championship.
4. Cross Country – Approved a variation in the classification numbers for Cross Country as follows:
 - Class A: 911 and up
 - Class B: 470-910
 - Class C: 260-469
 - Class D: 259 and below
5. Championship Gate Lists – Approved continuing the Gate List procedures for all team sports for the semi-final and final contest with the number of school representatives allowed on the list to remain at eight.
6. Strategic Plan – Approved the 2011-16 Strategic Plan.
7. Wrestling
 - Approved the additional language when a wrestler comes out for the team after the team’s certification day as follows: “A wrestler cannot begin practice until the waiver is approved. The approval date of the waiver starts the 14-day clock for certification.”

- Approved the new NFHS Wrestling Weight Classes with the addition of the 99 lb. weight class. The weight classes are: 99, 106, 113, 120, 126, 132, 138, 145, 152, 160, 170, 182, 195, 220 and 285.
 - Approved the minimum weight at which Selectively Classified wrestlers must weigh in. Selectively Classified athletes must weigh in excess of: 91 lbs. for 99 lb. weight class; 96 lbs. for 106 lb. weight class; 185 lbs. for 220 lb. weight class; and 210 lbs. for 285 lb. weight class. Students in grades 9-12 do not have to make minimum weight.
 - Approved in the Wrestling Weight Certification Handbook, the fee per wrestler charged by the Assessor will be determined by the Section.
 - Approved the NYSPHSAA Wrestling Advisory Committee's recommendation requiring a third measurement to all skin fold sites and to input data using Optimal Performance Calculation on the NWCA website.
 - Approved the use of the amended Wrestling Communicable Skin Disease Form.
8. Boys' Volleyball – Approved additional language to Boys' Volleyball NCAA Rule 2.1.2 Net Height. For boys' competition, the height of the net from the center of court is 7' 11 5/8".
 9. Dues – Approved a two-year freeze on the dollar amount paid on dues for 2011-12 for the 2012-13 and 2013-14 school years.
 10. Appeals – Approved a language change to letter b. of the Appeals Procedure.

NOTES:

1. Selection Classification – Lisa Lally announced to the Athletic Council that the Selection Classification process will be undergoing some major changes. More information will follow.

C. Counsel – Kevin Seaman

1. Residency – Mr. Seaman led a lengthy discussion regarding residency issues that schools face on a regular basis. He cautioned the Athletic Council that schools must verify residency prior to a student participating in interscholastic athletics. Additionally, schools must follow the prescribed "transfer rule" as outlined in the NYSPHSAA Handbook.

"Shall the Transfer Rule-b. include the following: "A student who transfers without a corresponding change in residence of his/her parents (or other persons with whom the student has resided for at least six months) is ineligible to participate in any interscholastic athletic contest in a particular sport for a period of one (1) year if as a 9-12 **grade** student participated in that sport, **or as a student in grade 7-8 participated in that sport at the high school level through the Selection Classification process** during the one (1) year period immediately preceding his/her transfer."

4. Wrestling Infectious Diseases Workshop – The Executive Director announced that Section XI will be hosting a Wrestling Infectious Diseases Workshop on Friday, October 21, 2011, with approximately 150 in attendance.
5. Coaching Certification – Huntington Athletic Director, Georgia McCarthy, informed the Athletic Council that she has numerous problems with the approval of coaches for temporary licenses who have returned to coaching following a long absence. Nick DeCillis and Lisa Lally will bring this issue to the attention of NYSPHSAA at the October 23-24, 2011 meeting.
