II. NYSPHSAA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

A. Status of State Championships

1. "Shall a two-year moratorium be placed on all state championships beginning with the 2013-14 school year."
2. "Shall the number of state championships be curtailed."

B. Sites of State Championships

1. "Shall the selection of state championship sites be based on a Section's desire to host."
2. "Shall a new process be developed by which members of the site selection committee are chosen."
3. "Shall a change in the transportation reimbursement structure be considered, with, perhaps, the Sections closest to the championship sites receiving less and those furthest receiving more."

- C. Uniforms – “Shall NYSPHSAA approve a policy eliminating student-athletes from wearing “Section” uniforms (singlets, t-shirts, etc.) at NYSPHSAA Championships. Student-athletes would be required to wear school-issued uniforms.”
- D. Academic Hardship Waiver – “Shall the Academic Hardship Waiver be eliminated from the Transfer Rule.”
- E. Charter Schools – The NYSPHSAA is seeking input from the Sections to gauge if the current rules and regulations are working for the Charter School members.
- F. Camp Rule – The NYSPHSAA received suggestions for a Camp Rule for High Schools and Athletic Shopping. The committee will be discussing these topics at the next Handbook Committee meeting. The committee is seeking input regarding these topics from the membership.
- G. Fiscal Issues - The NYSPHSAA is requesting the Section’s input on ways to reduce costs and increase revenues.

III. SECTION ACTION ITEMS

A. Fiscal Issues

The Fiscal Issues Committee met on Tuesday, January 10, 2012, at 9:30 am, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: Co-Chairs L. Lally and N. DeCillis; Conference I: L. Philips, D. Cronin; Conference II: R. Mayo, J. Pennacchio; Conference III: G. McCarthy (Absent: T. Mullins); Conference IV: D. Ferry, J. Lonardo; also D. Webster and E. Cinelli.

Also in attendance were the following Sport Chairs of “team sports” to review the costs associated with their sports: T. Combs (Football), K. Kauer (Field Hockey), K. Masterson (Boys’ Volleyball/Softball), R. Mayo (Boys’ Basketball), P. Murphy (Badminton), K. O’Reilly (Girls’ Basketball), P. Smith (Gymnastics), J. Thode (Girls’ Lacrosse), L. Tuorto (Girls’ Volleyball), J. Vasile-Cozzo (Girls’ Soccer), J. Wright (Softball). (Absent: M. Huey – Boys’ Soccer, J. Tasman – Baseball, T. Mullins – Boys’ Lacrosse).

The Committee asked the Sport Chairs to present information regarding the following items:

- Maximum number of contests
- Awards
- Supervision
- Rental of Outside Venues
- Participation in Regional and State Championships
- Number of Officials
- Number of Athletes Qualifying for the Section Tournament
- Placement Based on Geography

The following summation of these discussion items took place at the meeting:

1. Ed Cinelli reviewed the costs associated with each team sport’s number of contests, awards, supervision, rental of outside venues, and participation in regional and state championships.
2. A lengthy discussion took place regarding the costs associated with Section XI’s participation in NYSPHSAA regional and state championships. The Committee discussed the “lack of rotation” pertaining to the sites chosen for state championships. For example, it is rare that Long Island hosts a state championship while the Syracuse area is hosting six state championships this year. Nick DeCillis and Lisa Lally will bring this item to the state association meeting scheduled for Sunday, January 22, 2012.

3. Discussion took place regarding the number of officials assigned to contests. It was felt that consideration should be given to limiting the number of officials at the JV and Modified levels, particularly in softball, baseball, basketball and/or soccer. Additionally, officials fees could be decreased by:
 - Combining fees when officials are assigned to doubleheaders in field hockey and girls' lacrosse.
 - Scheduling scrimmages rather than non-league contests.
 - Utilizing the 4-quarter format rather than the 5-period format in modified sports.
4. Discussion took place regarding the number of teams that qualify for the state tournament. Committee members did not feel the need to change the qualifying standards.
5. The Committee felt that placement based on geography is a conference matter and should be discussed at that level when placement is being proposed.
6. Members of the Committee felt that the quality programs that have been established should be maintained at the Section level.
7. It was felt that the Section should investigate the possibility of acquiring corporate funding to offset costs.

B. Admissions – The Committee met on Wednesday, January 25, 2012, at 9 am, in the Section XI office. The members of the Committee in attendance were: Chair Nick DeCillis, Neil Lederer, Peter Daly and Debra Ferry. Also in attendance: Ed Cinelli and Don Webster.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the feasibility of Section XI charging admissions for Spring Track championships that are held at Port Jefferson High School.

Additionally, the Committee discussed the possibility of increasing the admission fees for Gymnastics and Swimming from \$5 to \$6, and charging admission fees for Section XI Softball (as the facility dictates).

The Committee also reviewed the 2010-11 admissions collected by Section XI and discussed the possibility of having the Section develop a revenue stream from corporate sponsorships.

The Committee recommends the following:

1. That a \$6 admission fee be charged at the Section XI Spring Track Championships effective spring 2011-12.
2. That the admission fees charged at Gymnastics and Swimming events be raised from \$5 to \$6.
3. That a \$6 admission fee be charged at Softball Semi-Finals and Finals (as the facility dictates).
4. That the admission fee for Fencing, that had been omitted from the Admission Charges and Sites for Sectional Competition in the Section XI Handbook, be included.

- C. Sportsmanship** – The Section XI Sportsmanship Committee met on Thursday, January 26, 2012, at 9:00 am, at the Section XI office. In attendance: Chair J. Thode; Conference I: P. Friel; Conference II: J. Pennacchio; Conference III: D. Fontana; Conference IV: not represented. Also in attendance: P. Blieberg, D. Webster and E. Cinelli.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the sportsmanship standards during free throws at basketball contests as stated in both the "Code of Conduct for Spectators" and the "Guidelines and Recommendations for Codes of Behavior for Coaches, Participants, Spectators and Administrators in Interscholastic Competition".

At the January 11, 2012 Athletic Council meeting, Sachem Athletic Director Pete Blieberg, expressed concern regarding these guidelines and felt that noise should be tolerated during free throw attempts as long as it is not abusive.

Additionally, the Committee discussed the "Spectator Code of Conduct" that is read prior to the start of Section XI contests.

The Committee discussed both the "Code of Conduct for Spectators" and the "Guidelines and Recommendations for Codes of Behavior for Coaches, Participants, Spectators and Administrators in Interscholastic Competition", and recommends the following:

1. Code of Conduct for Spectators (B.4)

"Stamping of feet, Taunting, foul and abusive language, inflammatory remarks and disrespectful signs and behavior are not acceptable. Violations during a free throw attempt will be penalized by repeating the free throw, if missed. The officials will make this decision."

2. Guidelines and Recommendations for Codes of Behavior for Coaches, Participants, Spectators and Administrators in Interscholastic Competition (IV.)

- 1) *Conform to accepted standards of good sportsmanship and behavior.*
- 2) *Respect officials, coaches, and players and extend all courtesies to them.*
- 3) *Refrain from foot stomping, disrespectful remarks, and the use of noisemakers. **Taunting, foul and abusive language, inflammatory remarks and disrespectful signs and behavior are not acceptable. Violations during a free throw attempt will be penalized by repeating the free throw, if missed. The officials will make this decision.***
- 4) *~~Be quiet when players need total concentration such as during free throws in basketball or serves in volleyball.~~*

- D. Tournament** – The Tournament Committee met on Thursday, February 09, 2012, at 11:00 am, at the Holbrook Country Club. In attendance: Chair T. Combs; Conference I: D. Cronin, G. Beutel; Conference II: J. Pennacchio, J. Sparacio; Conference III: J. Valente, J. Vasile-Cozzo; Conference IV: D. Phillips, J. Braico. Also in attendance: R. Panariello, D. Webster and E. Cinelli.

For Information Only:

Section XI Wrestling Chair, Bob Panariello, presented a proposal that would permit each League to send four wrestlers per weight class to the Section XI Division I tournament. Currently, Section XI permits only the top three from each League to participate in the Section XI tournament.

This proposal has come from the Wrestling Coaches' Association. If approved, the Coaches' Association is willing to pay any additional costs incurred, including additional hours of rental, officials' fees, etc., to offset any costs to the Section.

Following deliberation, the Committee decided to table the proposal, requesting that Mr. Panariello present specific costs to the Committee at its next meeting scheduled for April 25.
