II. REPORTS**A. Executive Board**

The Executive Board met on Monday, February 27, 2012, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President M. A. Jules, L. Lally, A. Gerstenlauer, K. Seaman, L. Light, P. Sullivan-Kriss, J. Dolan, D. Webster, and E. Cinelli. (Absent: J. Thode, J. Polansky, N. DeCillis, A. Annunziato)

1. President – Mary Anne Jules called the meeting to order at 4:08 pm.
2. NYSPPHSAA Reports – Lisa Lally
Ms. Lally reviewed the minutes of the January 22, 2012 NYSPPHSAA Executive Committee meeting and the January 31, 2012 NYSPPHSAA Central Committee meeting. Lisa highlighted the items that Nick DeCillis brought to the NYSPPHSAA Executive Committee. These items may be discussed or voted upon at the May Executive Board meeting. She also reviewed the January 2012 NYSED Physical Education and Athletics Update.
3. Treasurer – Larry Light
Mr. Light highlighted Section XI's Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2011 through February 22, 2012.
4. Counsel – Kevin Seaman
 - A. Independent Contractor – Mr. Seaman reviewed with the Board correspondence that was sent to the New York State Department of Labor regarding a claim that was made by an official. This official has submitted six prior applications for unemployment insurance. Officials have been declared "independent contractors" and are not entitled to Unemployment Insurance.
 - B. MSG Varsity/Verizon FiOS1 - A discussion took place regarding the proposals received by MSG Varsity and Verizon FiOS1. The Board will act on this item at its May 7, 2012 meeting.
 - C. NYSPPHSAA Records Retention Policy - The Board reviewed a sample of a "Record Retention Policy". This item will be brought to the Section Policy Committee for discussion and possible action.
5. President – Mary Anne Jules
Ms. Jules provided the Board with the Internal Auditor's report for January 27, 2012.
6. Fiscal Issues Committee – Nick DeCillis/Lisa Lally
Ms. Lally reviewed with the Board the minutes of the January 10, 2012 meeting of the Section's Fiscal Issues Committee. The Committee reviewed with the Section's "team" Sport Chairs fiscal issues that are associated with their sports. A recommendation was made that the Section should investigate the possibility of acquiring corporate funding. Kevin Seaman, Nick DeCillis, and Ed Cinelli will meet to develop a plan.
7. Executive Board Opening – 2012/13
The Executive Director announced the following opening beginning in the 2012/13 school year on the Executive Board:
 - Male Representative to the NYSPPHSAA Central Committee
 - Executive Board 2nd Vice President

This position of Male Representative to the NYSPPHSAA Central Committee is currently held by Nick DeCillis whose term will end in July, 2012. Information will be provided to member schools regarding these openings.

8. Outside Agencies - Approval was given to the following outside agencies to conduct competition during the 2011-12 school year:
 - Suffolk Country Track Coaches (Spring Track) – April 21, 2012
9. Cullen & Danowski - The Executive Board approved the engagement letter with the accounting firm of Cullen & Danowski, LLP, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012. The fee will remain the same as it was for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
10. OMNI 403B – The board approved Section XI's participation in the Preferred Provider Program (P3) offered by the OMNI Group.
11. Quarterly Expenses - The Executive Director provided the Board with the Meals and Refreshments expenses for the period January 3, 2012 through February 26, 2012.
12. Admissions Committee Report - The Executive Director provided the Board with a report on the January 25, 2012 Admissions Committee meeting.
13. Sportsmanship Committee Report - The Executive Director provided the Board with a report on the January 26, 2012 Sportsmanship Committee meeting.
14. Basic Conference Placement 2012-13 - The Executive Director provided the Board with the Basic Conference Placement for 2012-13. The placement is based on the SIRS data reports and calculated using the NYSPHSAA formula.
15. May 7, 2012 Executive Board Meeting - The May 7, 2012 Executive Board meeting will take place at Bridgehampton High School.

B. NYSPHSAA Central Committee – N. DeCillis, L. Lally, J. Dolan,
At its meeting on January 31, 2012, via phone conference, the NYSPHSAA Central Committee effected the following:

1. Classification Numbers - Approved the 2012-13 Classification Numbers as presented.
2. Championship Sites - Approved Ithaca College as the site for the 2012 and 2013 Girls' Swimming State Meet and the 2014 Boys' Swimming State Meet.
3. Legal Counsel – Approved a legal counsel contract with Renee James to be renewed annually.
4. Employee Handbook – Approved the purpose of the NYSPHSAA Employee Handbook.

C. NYSPHSAA Executive Committee – N. DeCillis, L. Lally
At its meeting on January 22, 2012, the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:

1. Cheerleading – Representatives from SED have informed the NYSPHSAA that, at this time, the Regents will not be acting on the NYSPHSAA request to include cheerleading as an interscholastic sport. It was noted that a tremendous effort has been made by the Cheerleading Committee to have cheerleading become a recognized sport, and the NYSPHSAA feels their efforts should be acknowledged. The NYSPHSAA Executive Committee approved a recommendation from the Executive Director to develop a plan to host an East and West Regional cheerleading event in 2012-13.
2. State Championships – Approved the 2012-13 NYSPHSAA Championship sites and dates.

3. Volleyball – Approved the Boys’ and Girls’ Volleyball Championships to be held at Glens Falls Civic Center (Sec 2) on November 17-18, 2012.
4. Baseball
 - a. Approved the Baseball Championships to be held in Binghamton (Sec 4) for the 2014-17 seasons.
 - b. Approved a change in the required number of baseball practices for a team to 10 for a scrimmage and 15 for a game at all levels effective with the 2012 spring season.
5. Tennis – Approved the reappointments of Chris Horgan as Girls’ Tennis Coordinator, and Selina DeCicco as Boys’ Tennis Coordinator.
6. Non-Member Schools – Approved the NYSPHSAA will approve events that have non-member schools participating provided there can be no direct compensation with a non-member school.
7. Budget and Audit Committee – Approved the structure and purpose of the NYSPHSAA Budget and Audit Committee.
8. NYSPHSAA Policies/Procedures – Approved the NYSPHSAA Technology Policy, Whistleblower Policy, Document Retention Policy and the Hiring Procedure.
9. Referendum Vote – Approved a referendum vote for proposed constitutional changes.
10. Handbook Revisions – Approved to amend the wording to Proposition#5: Article III Central Committee – Handbook p32, item 3a: *"Sectional representatives constitute the voting body of the committee and the first vice president, second vice president, and immediate past president shall have the right to vote when the Central Committee is in session. The president shall not be entitled to vote, except in the case of a tie."* (Rationale: This proposal was initiated on advice from counsel. When these officers serve on committees such as the Budget and Audit Committee and Compensation Committee, the Association will be in compliance with the IRS requirement for 501c3 Non-Profit organizations. The requirement is for the majority of committee members to be voting members of the Association.)
11. Girls’ Lacrosse – Approved in Girls’ Lacrosse a waiver to rule 2-13, 3 “side panel and trim around the neck” for the 2012-13 seasons.
12. Field Hockey – Approved in Field Hockey a waiver to rule 1-5-1, player uniforms, for the 2012-14 seasons.
13. Soccer – Approved in Soccer a waiver to rule 4-1-1, i.e., goal keeper jersey for the 2012-14 seasons and a waiver to rule 4-1-1b: home white jerseys for the 2013-15 seasons.
14. Football – Approved in Football a waiver to rule 1-5-1b, 6 and 7 for home and visiting jerseys for the 2012-14 seasons.
15. Wrestling
 - a. Approved a waiver to rule 4-1-5 to allow tape on the chin straps and straps on the top of the head gear.
 - b. Approved a waiver of the uniform rule during the month of February to permit pink ribbon(s) on the uniform in recognition of Breast Cancer Awareness initiatives.

16. Girls' Golf – Approved in Girls' Golf allowing competitors to use non-motorized push or pull carts during league, sectional or NYSPHSAA championship competition.
17. Fiscal Issues – Approved to extend the current NYSPHSAA fiscal recommendations to the 2012-13 school year.
18. Winter Track – Approved the reduction of the required number of contests in Winter Track from 6 contests to 4 contests for Sections 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and 11.
19. Friend and Neighbor – Approved as Friend and Neighbor: Yeshiva Derech Hatorah (Sec 8).
20. New Member – Approved as a New Member: Destiny Christian School (Sec 5).
21. Appeal Fee – Approved a fee of \$300 for a telephone conference call appeal that will be paid for in full by the Appellant.
22. College Rule – Approved additional language to the College Rule: *"Prior to competition, the NYSPHSAA Executive Director may grant an exemption of the College Rule for an individual sport athlete when vying for a standard that would qualify them for the Olympic trials and/or Olympic games when this opportunity is not offered through New York State Public High School Athletic Association and/or National Federation of State High School Associations. The exemption would permit a student to participate as an "unattached" individual with no affiliation to their school team in a competition against open and college competition in an approved competition set forth by the Olympic Committee without violating the College Rule".*
23. Softball – Approved the Class D realignment in Softball with the cut-off date of March 15th for Sections to announce if they will have any Class D schools.
24. Girls' Swimming – Approved the revised Girls' Swimming and Diving Qualifying Standards for the 2012 State Championships.
25. NYSPHSAA Audit – Approved authorizing Executive Director Nina Van Erk to develop a Request for Proposal for quotes and bids for an internal audit of the Association.
26. Treasurer
 - a. Approved the retirement of Kathleen Higle, NYSPHSAA Treasurer, effective May 31, 2012.
 - b. Approved directing the Executive Director to reduce the position of Treasurer to part-time and/or outsource duties of the position effective June 1, 2012.

D. NYSPHSAA Executive Director – Nina Van Erk

1. Ms. Van Erk outlined the following items:
 - Merging of school districts.
 - Procedures that the NYSPHSAA office follows with respect to the development of the classification breakdown.
 - Concussion management guidelines will be forthcoming from the SED.
2. Ms. Van Erk announced the possibility of the NYSPHSAA sponsoring a cheerleading invitational or championship during the 2012-13 school year. Specifically, plans have not yet been developed.

3. Ms. Van Erk discussed with the Athletic Council the discussion items that Nick DeCillis brought forth at the Central Committee meeting in January.

E. Counsel – K. Seaman

1. Mr. Seaman reviewed with the Athletic Council the fact that the Section has been receiving a number of New York State Unemployment Insurance claims submitted by officials. It was reiterated that officials are "independent contractors", not employees, and thus are not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits.
2. Mr. Seaman reviewed the proposals from MSG Varsity and Verizon FiOS1 for exclusive rights to broadcast Section XI championship events during the 2012-13 school year. A decision will be made at the next Executive Board meeting to be held in May.
3. A "Retention of Records" policy was discussed; a draft of this policy will be sent to the Section XI Policy Committee for discussion at their April 24th meeting for possible action.
4. Mr. Seaman spoke to the Athletic Council regarding Section XI involvement in a corporate sponsorship. It is possible that the Section might want to seek the help of a marketing firm that will assist the Section in developing sponsorship protocol.

III. NYSPHSAA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

President Mary Anne Jules asked each Conference to provide feedback regarding their feelings on the following topics:

- A. Status and Sites of State Championships - The Conferences were mixed with respect to Section XI's involvement in NYSPHSAA championships. However, they all agreed that there should be some State Association championships that are held on Long Island. Section XI travels off of Long Island for every state championships during the 2011-12 school year which is very costly to the Section. Additionally, some Conferences felt that it would better serve the largest schools in our Section to hold Long Island championships rather than participate at the state level. Discussion also took place regarding the selection process of sites for NYSPHSAA championships. There is a feeling that sport committees should not have the final say in this selection process.
- B. Uniforms - The Conferences had mixed feelings regarding a policy eliminating student-athletes from wearing "Section" uniforms (singlets, t-shirts, etc.) at NYSPHSAA Championships.
- C. Academic Hardship Waiver – The Conferences had mixed feelings regarding eliminating the Academic Hardship Waiver from the Transfer Rule."
- D. Charter Schools/Camp Rule – There was no discussion regarding the current rules and regulations for the Charter School members or the development of a "Camp Rule" as Section XI has no experience with either of these two issues.

IV. SECTION XI ACTION ITEMS**A. Admissions**

"Shall there be a \$6 admission fee charged at the Section XI Spring Track Championships effective spring 2011-12."

2. Gymnastics & Swimming

"Shall the admission fee charged at Gymnastics and Swimming events be raised from \$5 to \$6 effective 2012-13."

3. Softball

"Shall there be a \$6 admission fee charged at Softball semi-finals and finals (as the facility dictates) effective spring 2011-12."

4. Fencing

"Shall Fencing be listed to the list of sports charging an admission fee."

To approve the following:

1. Code of Conduct for Spectators (B.4)

"Shall the wording in the "Code of Conduct for Spectators" (B.4.) be amended as follows:

*"Stamping of feet, Taunting, foul and abusive language, **noisemakers**, inflammatory remarks and disrespectful signs and behavior are not acceptable. Violations during a free throw attempt will be penalized by repeating the free throw, if missed. The officials will make this decision."*

2. Guidelines and Recommendations for Codes of Behavior for Coaches, Participants, Spectators and Administrators in Interscholastic Competition (IV.)

"Shall the wording in the "Guidelines and Recommendations for Codes of Behavior for Coaches, Participants, Spectators and Administrators in Interscholastic Competition (IV.) be amended as follows:

- 1) *Conform to accepted standards of good sportsmanship and behavior.*
- 2) *Respect officials, coaches, and players and extend all courtesies to them.*
- 3) *Refrain from foot stomping, disrespectful remarks, and the use of **noisemakers**. **Taunting, foul and abusive language, noisemakers, inflammatory remarks and disrespectful signs and behavior are not acceptable. Violations during a free throw attempt will be penalized by repeating the free throw, if missed. The officials will make this decision.***
- 4) *Be quiet when players need total concentration such as during free throws in basketball or serves in volleyball.*
