- B. **Tournament** – The Tournament Committee met on Wednesday, September 19, 2012, at 10 am, in the Section XI office. In attendance: Chair: T. Combs; Conference I: D. Cronin; Conference II: J. Wright; Conference III: Not Represented; Conference IV: D. Phillips, J. Braico; also P. Cesare and E Cinelli.

The Committee recommends approval of the following:

1. Boys' and Girls' Tennis Individual Tournament – "Shall the Section XI Boys' and Girls' Tennis Individual Tournament use a USTA-certified official at no cost to Section XI." (One-year experiment for the 2012-13 school year.)
2. Softball - "Shall the Section XI Softball Tournament consist of a double elimination semi-final round in each classification bracket." Note: Currently, double elimination exists only in the final round. (One-year experiment for the 2012-13 school year.)

Notes:

1. Boys' and Girls' Tennis Individual Tournament - Discussion took place regarding the use of the Hamlet Golf and Country Club in Commack for the final day of the Section XI Boys' and Girls' Individual Tennis Tournament. The Hamlet facility has six tennis courts and would not be able to accommodate Section XI's needs on the first day of the tournament. Section XI Boys' Tennis Chair Joe Braico and Girls' Tennis Chair Pete Cesare will seek input from the coaches' associations regarding this issue.
 2. Boys' and Girls' Tennis Long Island Championship - Discussion took place regarding the future of the Long Island Championships in both Boys' and Girls' Tennis. A joint meeting of representatives from both Section XI and Section VIII will be scheduled to discuss this event.
 3. Softball – Discussion took place regarding the request from Section XI Softball Chair Jim Wright to use neutral sites and charge admission for Section XI championship Softball contests.
- C. **Modified** - The Modified Committee met on Thursday, September 20, 2012, at 10:00 am, in the Section XI Office. In attendance: Co-Chair: D. Robinson; Conference I: G. Beutel, L. Philips; Conference II: J. Pennacchio; Conference III: Not Represented; Conference IV: D. Ferry; also D. Webster and E. Cinelli.

The Committee recommends approval of the following:

1. Cross Country – "Shall the maximum distance in Cross Country be 1½ miles in the first half of the season and be increased to a maximum of 2 miles in the second half of the season, with the change-over date being the 5th Saturday of the season." (Effective 2013-14 school year.)
