



## II. REPORTS

### A. EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Executive Board met on Wednesday, January 2, 2013, at 4:00 pm, in the Section XI office. In attendance: D. Ferry, M.A. Jules, L. Lally, T. Mullins, P. Sullivan-Kriss, J. Dolan, P. Casciano, N. DeCillis, L. Light, K. Seaman, A. Groveman, D. Webster and E. Cinelli. (Absent: J. Thode, J. Polansky, D. Gamberg)

1. Acting President – Second Vice President Debra Ferry presided over the meeting in the absence of President Jeremy Thode and First Vice President James Polansky. The meeting was called to order at 4:10 pm.
2. Treasurer's Report – Larry Light  
Mr. Light reviewed the Section XI Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2012 through December 20, 2012, and provided information regarding the income and expenses within that budget period.
3. Counsel – Kevin Seaman
  - A. FOIL Requests – Mr. Seaman reviewed with the Executive Board copies of correspondence regarding the FOIL requests from the Suffolk County Eastern Baseball Association and Verizon FiOS.
  - B. Mixed Competition – A lengthy discussion took place regarding the Section XI Mixed Competition policy. The Executive Board recommends that the following revisions be made to the policy:  
*(Under B. "Documentation") – An evaluation will be conducted by a three-member panel consisting of the Sport Chair and two impartial Athletic Directors selected by Section XI to assess whether or not participation by a particular male student on a sport team organized for females in a district would **"have a significant adverse effect upon the opportunity of females to participate successfully in interschool competition in that sport"**.*
4. Internal Auditor's Report – Ed Cinelli  
The Executive Director provided the Board with the Internal Auditor's reports for October, November and December, 2012. He indicated that the Section issued 930 checks to pay officials and bills during this period.
5. NYSPPHAA – Lisa Lally/T. Mullins
  - A. Ms. Lally and Mr. Mullins provided a synopsis of the October 21, 2012 NYSPPHAA Executive Committee meeting held in Albany, and the November 2, 2012 Central Committee Meeting held via conference call.
  - B. NYSPPHAA Office reports for November and December 2012 were provided.
  - C. A note of appreciation from Nina Van Erk regarding her retirement dinner was distributed.
  - D. A flyer describing the NYSPPHAA Cheerleading Invitational was distributed.
6. NYSPPHAA Combining Committee Report – Nick DeCillis  
A lengthy discussion took place regarding the NYSPPHAA proposed combining policy. The Executive Board recommends that the Section approve this policy. Additionally, the Board recommends that the Section suspend the current Section XI combining policy for the period of one year to be reviewed at the December 2013 Placement Committee meeting.
7. Officials Negotiations – Nick DeCillis  
Mr. DeCillis updated the Board on a tentative proposal that the Section has developed with the Suffolk County Officials Presidents Council negotiations team.

8. Sponsorship Update – Nick DeCillis  
Mr. DeCillis provided information regarding the possibility that the Section will enter into an agreement with Spalding to utilize their products during Section XI championships. Additionally, Mr. DeCillis is working on agreements with Modells, Land Tek and School Sports Media. The Section is continuing to work with 2<sup>nd</sup> Wind on sponsorship for Section XI track and field.
9. Finance Committee – Alan Groveman  
The Section XI Finance Committee Chair, Alan Groveman, reviewed the December 4, 2012 Finance Committee meeting report, including the proposed 2013-14 budget. Mr. Groveman advised the Board that the Section XI accountant, Cullen & Danowski, LLP, has recommended that efforts be made to increase the fund balance as it has been declining over the past few years.
10. Team Total Update – Don Webster  
Don Webster provided the Executive Board with information regarding the number of Modified Teams for the Fall and Winter 2012-13 seasons. Mr. Webster announced that there has been no significant increase or decrease in the number of teams that schools are proposing during the 2013-14 school year.
11. OMNI 403(b) Amendment Adoption – The Executive Board approved the adoption of the OMNI 403(b) amendment.
12. Outside Agency Approval – The Executive Board retroactively approved the following outside agencies to conduct tournaments within Section XI:
  - Eastern Suffolk Officials Boys' Basketball Tournament – December 28-29, 2012
  - Western Suffolk Officials Boys' Basketball Tournament – December 27-28, 2012
13. NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame – The Executive Board retroactively approved the submission of the applications of Center Moriches Athlete Paul Gibson, and Official Joe Grady, for induction into the NYSPHSAA Hall of Fame in August, 2013.
14. Executive Director Goals and Objectives – Mid-Year Report – Ed Cinelli provided the Board with his mid-year report. Lisa Lally requested that Section XI provide a Secretaries' Workshop again this year. She felt that last June's workshop was a complete success and that those secretaries in attendance benefited tremendously from the presentations.
15. Section XI Quarterly Expenses – Ed Cinelli provided the Executive Board with the Meals and Refreshment expenses for the period October 1, 2012 through January 1, 2013.
16. Mixed Competition Appeal Hearing Report – Ed Cinelli provided the report from the December 6, 2012 Appeal Hearing relative to the request made by a member school to have a male student participate on a modified girls' volleyball team.
17. 2013-14 NYSPHSAA Championships – Ed Cinelli provided the listing of tentative dates and sites for the NYSPHSAA Championships during the 2013-14 school year.

**B. NYSPHSAA CENTRAL COMMITTEE**

At its meeting on November 2, 2012, via phone conference, the NYSPHSAA Central Committee effected the following:

1. Cheerleading - Approved taking the Cheer proposal back to the Sections for discussion and then be brought back as an Action Item at a special Executive Committee meeting scheduled for December 3, 2012, at 10 am.
2. Executive Session - Approved to enter into Executive Session.
3. Compensation Committee - Approved the Compensation Committee's recommendation.

**C. NYSPHSAA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE - L. Lally, T. Mullins**

At its meeting on October 21, 2012, the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:

1. Bylaws and Eligibility Standards - Approved additional language to the Bylaws and Eligibility Standards, #31 (pg.94 - NYSPHSAA Handbook) as per advice of Counsel.
2. Modified Program
  - a. Handbook - Approved a word changed in the last sentence of Modified Program, #13 Promotion, (2) (pg. 136-NYSPHSAA Handbook) for clarity for schools that do not have a JV team.
  - b. Wrestling - Approved in Modified Wrestling the weight variance of a contestant to compete against a Competitor who is either in a lower or higher weight group, as long as both wrestlers stay within the variance listed.
  - c. Badminton - Approved an editorial change in the Modified Badminton Games Rules (NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg. 142).
  - d. Tennis - Approved an editorial change in the Modified Tennis Game Rules (NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg. 153).
  - e. Cross Country - Approved an editorial change in the in the Modified Cross Country Game Rules (NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg. 144).
3. Discussion/Action Item (For January 2013 Executive Committee Meeting)
  - a. Fiscal reductions currently in effect be extended.

**III. COUNSEL - Kevin Seaman**

- A. Mr. Seaman reviewed the FOIL request from the Eastern Baseball Officials Association and the correspondence that he has had with the "Committee for Open Government."
- B. Mr. Seaman reviewed the FOIL request from Verizon FiOS and indicated that Section XI is not subject to FOIL as a not-for-profit organization. Additionally, MSG Varsity has "commercial trade secrets that should not be accessible in a FOIL request.
- C. Mr. Seaman gave a lengthy dissertation regarding the State Education Department's Mixed Competition regulation and outlined the rationale for Section XI's decision. In addition, he suggested that NYSPHSAA Executive Director Robert Zayas pursue this issue with the New York State Commissioner of Education to develop guidelines, including a definition of "adverse effect."

**IV. NYSPHSAA EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR – Robert Zayas**

- A. Mr. Zayas provided information regarding his professional background as Assistant Executive Director of the New Mexico high school athletic association and spoke of his enthusiasm to be named the NYSPHSAA Executive Director. He outlined his goals and indicated his desire to update the NYSPHSAA website and to develop more “consistency” at state championships regarding awards and venues.
- B. Mr. Zayas announced that he has scheduled a meeting later this month with the Commissioner of Education. On the agenda, he plans to discuss Mixed Competition and Concussion Management, with the hope of promoting the NFHS concussion management course as the approved course.

"Shall the Section XI Team Championship qualifying standards be adjusted as follows:

- All girls' teams that have a five-person average of ~~24:00~~ **23:00** minutes during a sanction 5K race at Sunken Meadow will qualify.
- Female individuals who have run ~~22:30~~ **22:00** for a 5K at a sanction cross country meet at Sunken Meadow will qualify.

2. Cheerleading – Amy Agnesini informed the Athletic Council why she felt the Section XI cheerleading squads are not participating in the NYSPHSAA Cheerleading Invitational. She feels the NYSPHSAA should adjust the regulation regarding the cheerleading starting date to accommodate our schools.
3. Scholar-Athlete Teams
  - President Thode recognized the Section XI schools that received NYSPHSAA Scholar-Athlete status during the Fall 2012 sports season. (Attachment A).
  - President Thode acknowledged the Ward Melville Girls' Tennis team as the NYSPHSAA Scholar-Athlete state winner.
4. In Memoriam – President Thode announced the passing of George Reh, father of Mount Sinai Athletic Director Scott Reh. George Reh was a long time track coach at Newfield High School.
5. Acknowledgements
  - President Thode announced that Port Jefferson Athletic Director Debra Ferry was the recipient of the *Port Jefferson Time Record* "Woman of the Year in Sports" designation.
  - President Thode announced that Patchogue-Medford Athletic Director Tom Combs has been named the Suffolk County Athletic Director of the Year.
