II. REPORTS**A. Executive Board**

The Executive Board met on Monday, February 25, 2013, at 4:00 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President J. Thode, D. Ferry, M. A. Jules, L. Lally, T. Mullins, P. Sullivan-Kriss, J. Dolan, P. Casciano, D. Gamberg, K. Seaman, L. Light, D. Webster, and E. Cinelli. (Absent: J. Polansky and N. DeCillis)

1. President – Jeremy Thode called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm.
2. Cullen & Danowski, LLP – Following a presentation by Donald J. Hoffmann from the accounting firm of Cullen & Danowski, LLP, the Executive Board approved the engagement letter with the firm for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. Cullen & Danowski, LLP, will prepare the financial statements in addition to providing the audit.
3. Corporate Sponsorship – Vernon Pindar, Spalding Customer Business Manager, proposed to the Executive Board the adoption of Spalding products in basketball, football, volleyball, soccer, softball and baseball. The Board will consider the proposal after samples are reviewed by the soccer and volleyball sport chairs.
4. NYSPHSAA Reports – Lisa Lally/Tim Mullins
 - A. Ms. Lally and Tim Mullins reviewed the minutes of the January 29, 2013 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting, highlighting the approved “Combining of Teams Regulation”, the approval of the wearing of Section uniforms at NYSPHSAA championships, and the continuation of fiscal reductions that will remain in effect for a two-year period (2013-14 and 2014-15 school years. In addition, The Knox School was approved as a member beginning July 1, 2013. The next NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting will be Friday, March 22, 2013, in Albany.
 - B. Robert Zayas meeting with the NYS Commissioner of Education was discussed.
 - C. Section XI Basic Conference Placement - The Executive Director provided the Board with the Basic Conference Placement for 2013-14. The placement is based on the SIRS data reports and calculated using the NYSPHSAA formula.
5. Treasurer – Larry Light
Mr. Light highlighted Section XI’s Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual report for the period July 1, 2012 through February 19, 2013.
6. Counsel – Kevin Seaman
Mr. Seaman reported to the Executive Board on the following issues:
 - A. Freedom of Information
 - a. Verizon FiOS – Based on the opinion of the “Committee on Open Government”, Section XI is subject to FOIL. The Section has provided Verizon FiOS with the documents that were requested.
 - b. Eastern Suffolk Baseball Umpires Association – The request for “rating cards” by the Eastern Baseball Umpires Association has been denied based upon a previous Supreme Court decision.
 - B. Mixed Competition Correspondence with Robert Zayas – Mr. Seaman discussed his correspondence with NYSPHSAA Executive Director Robert Zayas regarding Mixed Competition and the “impact” a boy would have if approved to play on a team organized for girls.

C. US Department of Education Athletics for the Disabled Recommendations – Mr. Seaman reviewed with the Executive Board the January 25, 2013 letter from the Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights on the matter of providing accommodations for disabled students who wish to participate in athletic programs.

7. President – Jeremy Thode

Mr. Thode provided the Board with the Internal Auditor's report for January 11, 2013.

8. Executive Board Opening – 2013-14

The Executive Director announced the following opening beginning in the 2013-14 school year on the Executive Board:

- Principal Representative to the NYSPHSAA Central Committee

This position of Principal Representative to the NYSPHSAA Central Committee is currently held by John Dolan whose term will end in July, 2013. Information will be provided to member schools regarding this opening.

9. Outside Agencies - Approval was given to the following outside agencies to conduct competition during the 2012-13 school year:

- Islip vs. Sayville Varsity Wrestling Match @Hofstra – January 16, 2013
- Suffolk County Track Coaches Assn. (Spring Track) – April 13, 2013
- Suffolk County Track Officials Assn. (Spring Track) – April 13, 2013
- Suffolk County Track Coaches Assn. (Spring Track) – April 20, 2013
- BPO Elks Annual Track Meet (Spring Track) – May 11, 2013

10. Quarterly Expenses - The Executive Director provided the Board with the Meals and Refreshments expenses for the period January 2, 2013 through February 24, 2013.

11. Section XI Consultant for Corporate Funding Position – Discussion took place regarding a request to provide a stipend and/or commission for the Section XI Consultant for Corporate Funding. This item will discuss this further at the May 13, 2013 Executive Board meeting.

12. Section XI Staffing Proposal 2013-14 – The Executive Board approved the creation of a .7 FTE position for the 2013-14 school year. This is supported by the 2013-14 Section XI budget. This position will replace the current part-time position.

13. Printer – The Executive Board approved Pine Barrens Printing of Westhampton to replace Ronkonkoma Printing which closed earlier this school year to provide printing services to the Section XI office.

B. NYSPHSAA Executive Committee

At its meeting on January 29, 2013, via conference call, the NYSPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:

1. Combining – Approved revising the Combining of Teams regulation by using a graduated scale of a schools' "5-sport classification cut-off numbers" in place of 100% BEDS numbers as a two-year pilot effective the 2013-14 school year. The graduated scale will be AA-50%; A-40%; B-30%, C-30%, and D-20%.

2. Section Uniforms – Approved allowing Sections the option to participate in Section uniforms at the NYSPHSAA individual championships as long as no cost is charged to the students, schools or Section effective immediately.
3. State Sport Coordinators – Approved the reappointments of the following State Sport Coordinators effective September 1, 2013 to August 31, 2014: Marty Sherman (Wrestling); David Hennessey (Girls' Indoor Track and Field); Bev Hooper (Field Hockey); and Peter Hugo (Boys' Swimming and Diving).
4. Championship Events – Approved the 2013-14 NYSPHSAA Championship events with changes.
5. Enrollment Numbers – Approved the 2013-14 school enrollment numbers for the NYSPHSAA member schools.
6. Fiscal Concerns – Approved the January 2009 fiscal reductions to remain in effect for a two-year period (2013-14 and 2014-15 school years).
7. NYSPHSAA Website – Approved \$30,000 to begin the NYSPHSAA website redesign.
8. Girls' Lacrosse
 - a. Approved to extend the current waiver of Rule 2-13, "3-inch side panel and trim around the neck" for the 2013-15 seasons.
 - b. Approved revising the current classification cut-off numbers to: Class A: 1050-up; Class B: 650-1049; Class C: 0-649.
9. Softball – Approved Moreau State Park, South Glens Falls (Sec II) as the site of the 2014-26 NYSPHSAA Softball State Championships.
10. Girls' Golf – Approved the use of distance measuring devices as stated by the USGA rules for all NYSPHSAA regular season, Sectional and State Championship events.
11. Boys' Lacrosse – Approved revising the current classification cut-off numbers in Boys' Lacrosse to: Class A: 1000-up; Class B: 590-999; Class C: 0-589.
12. Modified – Approved a language change in the Modified Baseball and Softball Substitution Game Rule.
13. Membership – Approved as a new member The Knox School (Section XI).

C. Counsel – K. Seaman

1. FOIL Request – Verizon FiOS – Mr. Seaman reviewed the FOIL request from Verizon FiOS and the fact that Section XI is declared subject to FOIL by the Committee on Open Government.
2. Mixed Competition – Mr. Seaman discussed his views regarding Mixed Competition which he has shared with NYSPHSAA Executive Director Robert Zayas.
3. Athletics for Disabled Students – A lengthy discussion took place regarding the United States Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights on the matter of providing athletics for disabled students who wish to participate in school athletic programs.

III. NYSPHSAA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

President Jeremy Thode asked each Conference to provide feedback regarding their feelings on the following topics:

1. SIRS School Enrollments - "Shall the SIRS school enrollments be used for TWO years in determining school classification."

2. Ungraded Students - "Shall school enrollments NOT contain 'ungraded' students."

IV. SECTION XI ACTION ITEMS**A. Tournament**

1. Soccer

Motion: T. Mullins Second: D. Ferry

To approve the following:

- a. Ties During Playoff Contests

"Shall a contest during the Section XI playoffs in Boys' Soccer and Girls' Soccer be declared a 'tie game' if, following overtime periods of the contest, the score is tied." NOTE: Sudden victory penalty kicks will be used only to determine which team advances.

- b. Co-Champion Status

"Shall both teams be declared co-champions in the Section XI Classification Championship if, after both overtime periods of the championship contest, the score is tied." NOTE: Sudden victory penalty strokes will be used to determine which team advances.

2. Field Availability

To approve the following:

"Shall a contest be moved to the visiting school during the Section XI playoffs if the home school does not have a site available to play."

3. Girls' Bowling

Motion: T. Mullins Second: R. Mayo

To approve the following:

- a. Playoffs

"Shall the top three teams in each league qualify for the playoffs (if there are three leagues) plus a Wild Card." NOTE: This would guarantee an even amount of teams in the playoffs (avoiding a pacer team), allowing for a meaningful end of the season tournament similar to the Boys' Division Tournament.

b. Wild Card Tournament

"Shall the Holiday Tournament be replaced by a Wild Card Tournament which would consist of all teams not qualifying for a playoff spot. The highest total wood for three games will make the playoffs as a 10th seed."

c. Section XI Championships

"Shall the Girls' Bowling Tournament be held the week prior to the Boys' Bowling Tournament." NOTE: This would avoid the overcrowding/mayhem that occurs by having the Boys' and Girls' County Championships at the same time. In addition, it would allow the Girls a chance to be in the spotlight by themselves, save a weekend of extended season pay/transportation for some school districts, and allow the boys and girls to watch each others tournaments.

Vernon Pindar agreed to supply the soccer and volleyball sport chairs with samples of the balls as requested by the Executive Board at their meeting on February 25th. The Board will review this item at their next regularly scheduled meeting.
2. Football Schedules – The Athletic Council approved allowing the districts that have a policy prohibiting practices on Jewish holidays to reschedule their Wednesday, September 11th football contest until Thursday, September 12th. Note: The Section XI staff will utilize current rescheduling procedures if requests are made by districts. Districts must provide rationale for the change and it must be approved by either the Executive Director or the Assistant Director.
