Each school I league will play each other twice (one home and one away) and crossover once for a total of 13 league contests. ALL matches will count towards the league standings.

Home and away for the Mandatory Non- League meets shall be determined based on the current formula for crossovers used by softball.

Traditional meets, such as the Brentwood Holiday Tournament and the Huntington Relays will remain as official contests and count towards the maximum of 20 permitted by Section XI.

Schools may schedule the remaining 5 Non-League contests as they see fit, providing they are contested against schools in the NYSPHSAA or that those out of state schools are sanctioned by their state organization. These matches will not count towards their league standings.

In the event of a tie, the following criteria will be used to determine league standings.

- 1- Head to Head
- 2- Common Opponents

If the teams remain tied, then both will be named Champions for their respective league.

The six (6) bout minimum for qualifying for the postseason is in effect.

 - JV will participate in 5 section scheduled contests. 1 less as per coaches.
 - Middle school will participate in 3 section scheduled contests.
 - Your average score will be tallied from the 6 section scheduled contests. A forfeit will result in 0 points per forfeit.
 - If a team performs without the correct number on the mat (small 5-16, large 17-32; Coed 5-32) that team for that performance will receive a score from the officials for feedback purposes only. You will not be eligible for an award or place in the competition and will receive a “0” on the result sheet and a “0”(varsity) averaged into your scores for that days performance In essence, your school did not meet the procedural requirement and your team is deemed ineligible.

 - Division I: 750 (BEDS) and up**
 - Small Squad 5 to 16 competitors on the mat
 - Large Squad: 17 to 32 competitors on the mat

 - To qualify for the County championship we will take the top 50% in each division and the winner in each division will go to the states. (Thus sending 5 teams)
 - JV (Small 5-16) & Large (17 to 32)
 - Middle School (1 division)
