II. REPORTS

A. EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Board met on Monday, March 6, 2006, at 4:08 pm, at the Section XI Office. In attendance: President W. Shierant, L. Lally, R. Goldin, N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson, P. Ferenz, J. Ruck, L. Light, K. Seaman, D. Madison, J. Sexton and E. Cinelli. (Absent: A. Dignam, J. Finello, and L. Schwartz).

1. President – President Wayne Shierant called the meeting to order at 4:08 pm. He announced the appointment of Jeremy Thode as Section XI State Sportsmanship Committee Co-Chair with Mike Browne. President Shierant also congratulated Nick DeCillis on his upcoming induction into the Suffolk County Sports Hall of Fame on Monday, May 1, 2006.
2. NYSPHSAA Reports – Paula Nickerson and Nick DeCillis reported on items addressed at the January 2006 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting:
 - A language amendment to the Transfer Rule was approved: *“Students who return from any school to the public school district of their residence shall be exempt from the Transfer Rule. Such a transfer without penalty will only be permitted once in a high school career.”*
 - A proposal for the Wrestling State Championships to fill the byes using a “wild card” formula as a 2-year experiment for 2006-07 and 2007-08 was approved.
 - The effort of Assemblyman Morelle to change the qualifying procedures for state championships was discussed.
3. Treasurer’s Report – Section XI Treasurer, Larry Light, provided a “Profit and Loss Budget vs. Actual” statement for Section XI for the period July 1, 2005 through February 24, 2006. In addition, he reported on the financial situation of the Section and the position of Section XI Treasurer.
4. Counsel – Kevin Seaman provided information on the following:
 - The possible wrestling litigation involving a wrestler that was not entered into the Section XI Division 2 tournament, indicating that there was no “order to show cause”.
 - Mr. Seaman announced that he was advised by the court that the litigation involving a basketball coach and Section XI has been set down for a return date of May 10, 2006.
 - Mr. Seaman commented that a request was made to the NYSPHSAA from the Suffolk County Comptroller requesting copies of NYSPHSAA financial statements.
5. Executive Board Sub-Committee on the Management Letter – The Executive Director presented a report of the Executive Board Sub-Committee to review the November 15, 2005 management letter from Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP. This sub-committee met on January 31, 2006, and March 1, 2006, in the Section XI office. Members of the sub-committee include Chairman Jim Ruck, Larry Light, Lisa Lally, Kevin Seaman, Donna Madison and Ed Cinelli. After lengthy discussion, the following actions were approved:
 - A. Financial Policies -
 - A draft of the policy regarding meals and refreshments at meetings was referred to the Policy Committee for action.
 - Written job duties and an organizational chart were presented.
 - Section XI financial procedures were presented with a recommendation that the procedures be reviewed by Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP.
 - Expense reimbursement policy changes were referred to the Policy Committee for action.
 - Sport Chair Responsibilities:
 - 1) Student Behavior - A statement regarding student behavior at championship events will be referred to the Policy Committee for action.
 - 2) Reimbursements - A recommendation to change the mileage reimbursement will be referred to the Policy Committee for action.
 - 3) Stipends - The Executive Director was directed to provide information to the Executive Board with a comparison of Section XI sport chair stipends with those from other Sections.

- A description of the duties of the Treasurer will be referred to the Policy Committee for action.
 - B. Claims Auditor – The Executive Board recommends the hiring of a Claims Auditor. A draft of a job description will be referred to the Policy Committee for action. The Executive Board does not recommend the hiring of an Internal Auditor.
 - C. Segregation of Duties – No further action is necessary.
 - D. Collateralization of Cash Accounts – No further action is necessary.
 - E. Bank Reconciliation – No further action is necessary.
 - F. Purchasing and Payment of Claims – No further action is necessary.
 - G. Net Assets – The Executive Board recommends that Section XI allocate \$500,000 into a capital fund for the future housing requirements of the Section XI office. The Executive Board recommends that Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP provide the Section with appropriate direction regarding this issue.
 - H. Retirees Health Insurance – The Executive Director will investigate this issue with the NYSPHSAA health insurance program.
 - I. Gate Receipts – Beginning with the winter 2005-06 Section XI tournaments, a procedure has been developed where all cash gate receipts are placed in a bank bag, sealed and deposited directly in the State Bank night deposit. State Bank has agreed to count all monies deposited and notify Section XI of the dollar amount. Additionally, the Section has made an agreement with John Dee of Athletic Event Management Services to provide personnel to collect gate and provide security at Section XI tournaments. Included would be the transportation of the cash to the State Bank night deposit. Athletic Event Management Services will be responsible for insurance and bonding as well as payment of their staff.
 - J. Fixed Assets – This item will be presented to Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP to determine useful life and depreciation history.
 - K. Section XI Staff – The Executive Board approved the increase in staff at the Section XI office to allow for an additional full-time Sport Coordinator and the reallocation of staff to provide support for accounting procedures.
 - L. Review of School Billing Procedure – The Executive Director provided a sample of a seasonal statement of officials billing for individual schools.
6. Executive Board Vacancies – The Executive Director announced the following vacancies for the 2006-07 school year:
- 2nd Vice President of Executive Board – Athletic Administrator (Applications received by Nominating Committee and Referendum vote).
 - Superintendent Representative to the NYSPHSAA Central Committee (appointed by Superintendents).
7. Appointment of Treasurer – The Executive Board approved the reappointment of Larry Light as Section XI Treasurer for a 5-year term beginning in 2006-07.
8. Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP – The Executive Board approved the accounting firm of Coughlin Foundotos Cullen & Danowski, LLP to undertake and complete the accounting and auditing procedures of Section XI finances for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006
9. Subsequent Arrest – The Executive Board reinstated a baseball official who had been on probation during the 2004-05 school year.
10. Newsday Article Re: NYSPHSAA Wrestling Championship – The Executive Director commented on this article and the difficulties that were encountered at the state wrestling tournament held at the Nassau Coliseum.

11. NYSPPHSAA Championship Dates – A copy of the 2006-07 NYSPPHSAA championship dates was distributed.
 12. Girls' Golf – The Executive Director announced that Section XI will be participating in the NYSPPHSAA girls' golf championships.
 13. Transportation Issues – The Executive Director commented on the difficulties encountered with finding adequate transportation for our student-athletes to attend state championships. The Montauk Bus Company has been extremely cooperative in this regard to both Section XI and Section VIII.
 14. Newspaper Articles – The Executive Director provided a number of newspaper articles to the Executive Board regarding interscholastic athletics.
- B. NYSPPHSAA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE – N. DeCillis, P. Nickerson
At its January 27, 2006 meeting, the NYSPPHSAA Executive Committee effected the following:
1. State Coordinator Appointments
 - Approved the appointment of Kristin Fullam as Boys Tennis Coordinator to serve through August 31, 2010.
 - Approved the reappointment of Dick Cerone as Football State Coordinator for a 5-year term effective September 1, 2006.
 - Approved the reappointment of Mike Andrew as Boys Soccer State Coordinator for a 5-year term effective September 1, 2006.
 - Approved the reappointment of Eileen Troy as Girls Basketball State Coordinator for a 5-year term effective September 1, 2006.
 2. 2006-07 Classification – Approved to accept as official the enrollment numbers presented for 2006-2007 Classification of Schools.
 3. Modified Sports Rule Revision – Approved Section VIII's Modified Playing Time request beginning with the winter 2006 season.
 4. Transfer Rule Amendment – Approved a language amendment to the Transfer Rule. *"Students who return from any school to the public school district of their residence shall be exempt from the Transfer Rule. Such a transfer without penalty will only be permitted once in a high school career."*
 5. Armbands – Approved the wearing of a memorial patch/armband when in accordance with the sport specific rules will be permitted.
 6. Friends and Neighbors - Approved as Friends and Neighbors the Stella Maris Regional School (Section XI).
 7. Wrestling – Approved for the Wrestling State Championship to fill the byes using a "wild card" formula as a 2-year experiment for 2006-07 and 2007-08.
 8. Cross Country - Approved 5 classes of competition to continue for the Boys/Girls Cross Country State Championships.
 9. Boys Soccer - Approved to create the position of Reserve Official in Boys Soccer effective with the 2006 State Championship.

10. Handbook Changes

- Approved to add the definition of "Competitor" to the NYSPHSAA Handbook: *"COMPETITOR-Any competitor must be a bona fide student in the member school district represented and is considered to be the school team or part of such team. Compliance with all NYSPHSAA by laws and standards and conformance with all NYSED regulations is required. Participation as an individual competitor counts toward the maximum number of contests permitted and meets the requirements of the Representation Standard."*
- Approved to add the definition of "Exhibition Competitor" to the NYSPHSAA Handbook: *"EXHIBITION COMPETITOR - An exhibition competitor is a bona fide student in the member school district represented and is a non-scoring participant in an interschool contest or tournament. Exhibition competitors may only compete with or against other exhibition competitors and be non-scoring/non-placing in the event. Exhibition competitors may fill open lanes in the sports of swimming and track and field. The maximum number of events permitted at a meet may not be exceeded. Participation as an exhibition competitor counts toward the maximum number of contests permitted and meets the requirements of the Representation Standard."*
- Approved to add a sentence regarding post season competition under Next Previously Scheduled Contest on pg. 52 of the Handbook: *"Any post season competition is considered previously scheduled"*.
- Approved additional language to the Code of Conduct-Supervisors Responsibilities: *"9. Abstain from the use of alcohol and controlled substances (unless prescribed by a physician); 10. Abstain from gambling of any kind; and ...and to myself and will accept any discipline that may be administered against me for any infraction of this Code."* to the NYSPHSAA Code of Conduct-Supervisors Responsibilities was approved. *Wording regarding which coach signs the Code of Conduct; the Sectional Coach or the school coach of the student athlete and what happens if a coach doesn't sign the Code of Conduct will be discussed at the next Handbook Committee meeting.*
- Approved editorial revisions in Bowling on pages 100 & 104, in the Chart on page 76 and Standards on page 78 of the Handbook. The editorial revisions of changing YABA to read USBC (United States Bowling Congress) in Bowling on pages 100 & 104 of the Handbook and in the Chart on page 76 and Standard on page 78 of the Handbook.

11. Ad-Hoc Committee – President Kathy Faber stated an Ad hoc committee will be formed to evaluate the current practice of general representation and representation at state tournaments. If anyone is interested in serving on the committee, please notify Kathy or Nina.

12. Discussion Items – May Meeting

- The NYSPHSAA ACTION on TARGET Committee recommends the following: *"Failure of a member school to attend a Section mandated workshop will result in ineligibility for NYSPHSAA State Tournaments the following school year."*
- The NYSPHSAA ACTION on TARGET Committee recommends that the position statement as currently appearing on pg. 119 of the 2004-2006 Handbook should be amended as follows: *"No coach should use alcohol, tobacco or other drugs before, during or immediately after the conclusion of an athletic contest/event sponsored and/or approved by NYSPHSAA, Inc. member schools."*
- Section 1 asked if a committee should be formed to review if cheerleading is a sport. It was decided to take this issue back to the Sections for discussion, and it will be placed as a Discussion Item on the agenda of the May Executive Committee meeting.

Exhibition competitors may only compete with or against other exhibition competitors and be non-scoring/non-placing in the event. Exhibition competitors may fill open lanes in the sports of swimming and track and field. The maximum number of events permitted at a meet may not be exceeded. Participation as an exhibition competitor counts towards the maximum number of contests permitted and meets the requirements of the Representation Standard.”*
- Transfer Rule New Language – *“Students who return from any school to the public school of their residence shall be exempted from the transfer rule. Such a transfer without penalty will only be permitted once in a high school career.”*
- Next Previously Scheduled Contest – *Any post season competition is considered previously scheduled.”*

9. Sport Committee Progress

- Girls Tennis – The committee will be proposing the adoption of the “Commitment to Play” declaration for the state tournament.
- Boys Basketball – The committee is seeking support for three-person officiating for the regional contests and the state tournament.
